**Soon you will be registering for your national exams and your school will help you to do so. Below are some important tips about the Registration process and sitting for your examinations:**

How many subjects can I register for? Do I need to pay for the exam?



You can find out all these important details by reading the **Registration Information for School Candidates** at <https://www.seab.gov.sg>. If you are a **Singaporean PR/International student**, do make payment through GIRO/Cash/Cheque in April.



I received my **Verification Slip** from teacher. What do I have to do?



You need to check your **personal particulars** and **subjects** are correct. Tell your teacher if there are **any errors for amendment**.



I have a Smart Watch. Can I wear it during the exam? What are the **do's and don'ts** during the exam?



Electronic devices are not allowed in the exam venue. There are other rules and regulations which you'll need to know. Do read the **Examination Rules and Regulations For School Candidates** booklet to find out more.



When will I receive my **Entry Proof**? If I have further questions, what should I do?



You will receive your **Entry Proof** from your school at least **3 weeks** before your exam. You can approach your teacher for more information.
