# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

Students who wish to apply for admission to

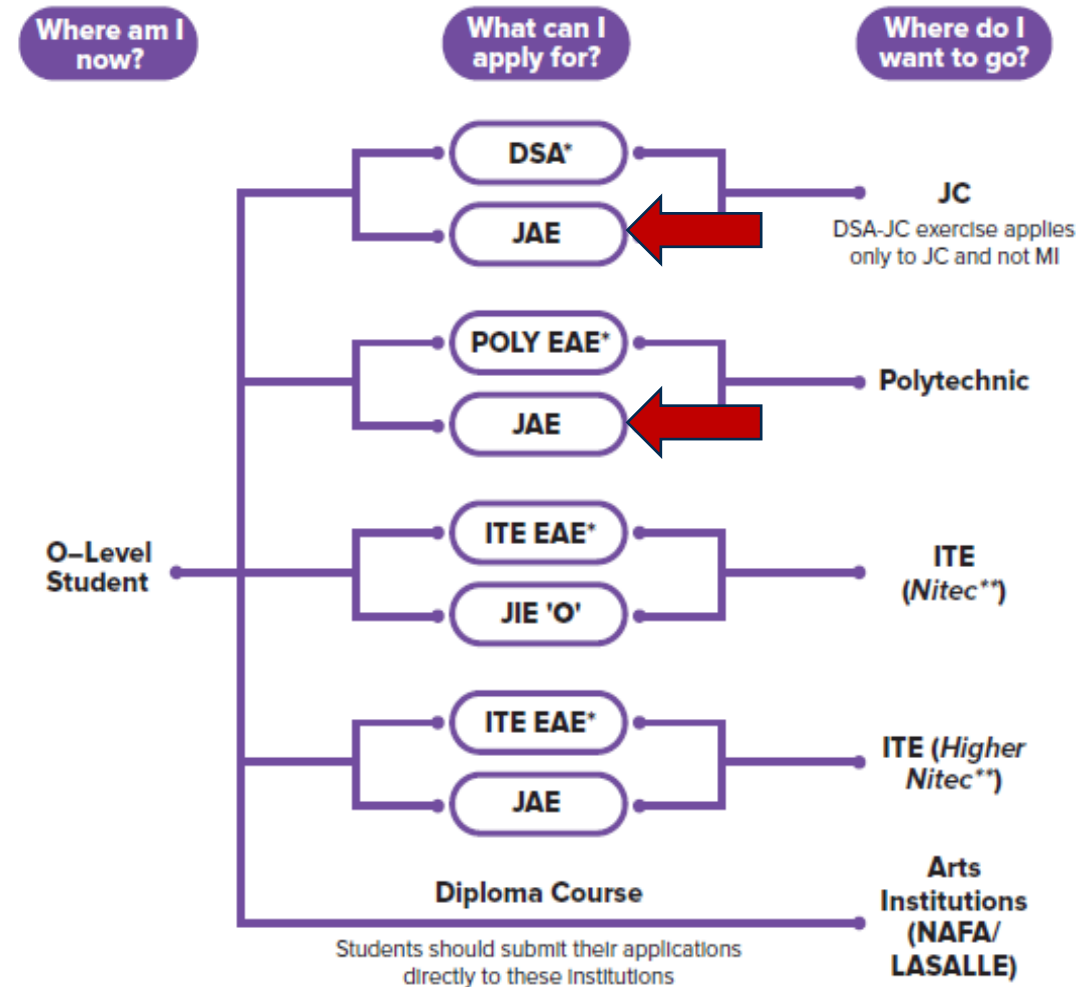
- junior colleges (JC),
- Millennia Institute (MI), polytechnics, and the
- Institute of Technical Education (ITE) may do so via the **Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)** using their GCE O-Level examination results.



# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) – Form A

- Eligible school candidates will receive a digital copy of Form A via their registered email addresses on **Thursday, 11 January 2024**.
- Form A will list the applicant's gross aggregate scores for JC, MI, Polytechnic, ITE aggregate types and courses which he/she is eligible to apply for under the JAE.

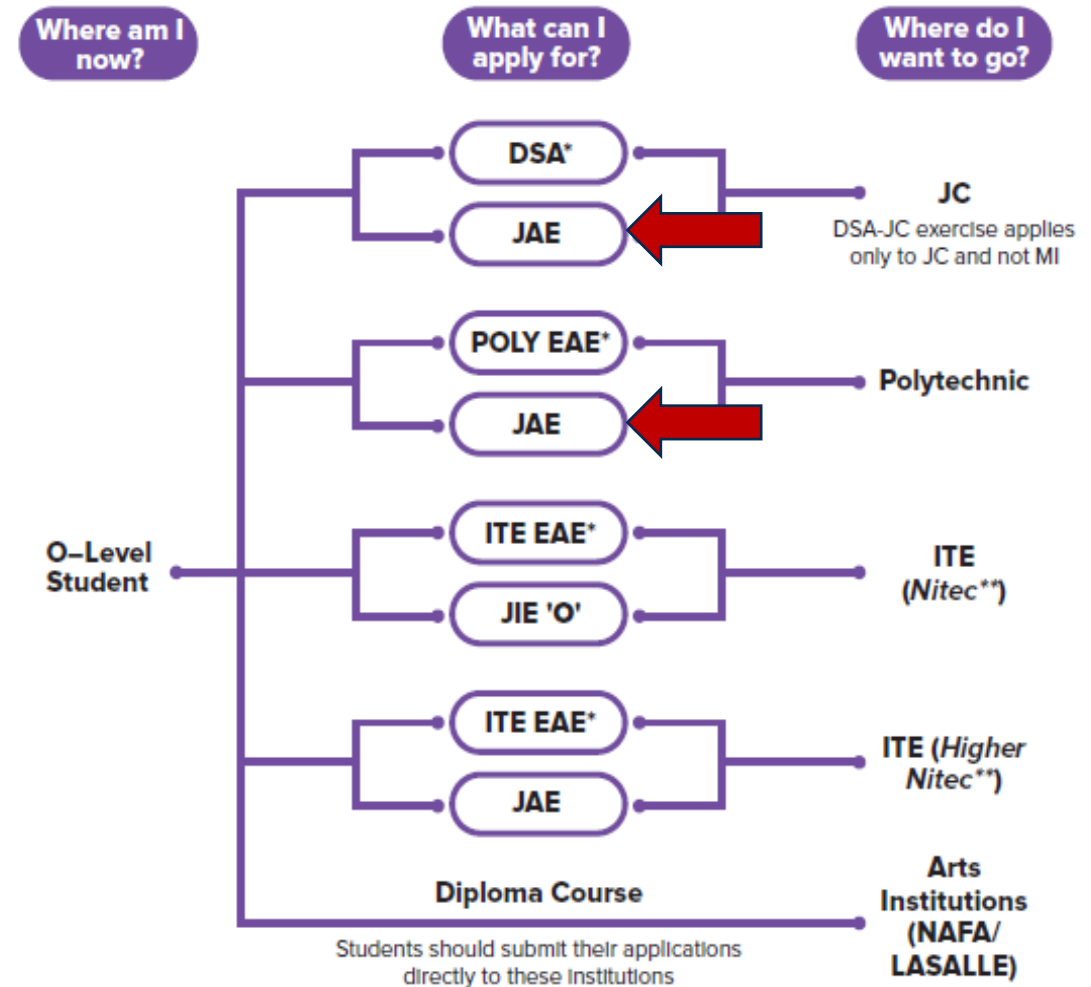

## Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) – Form A

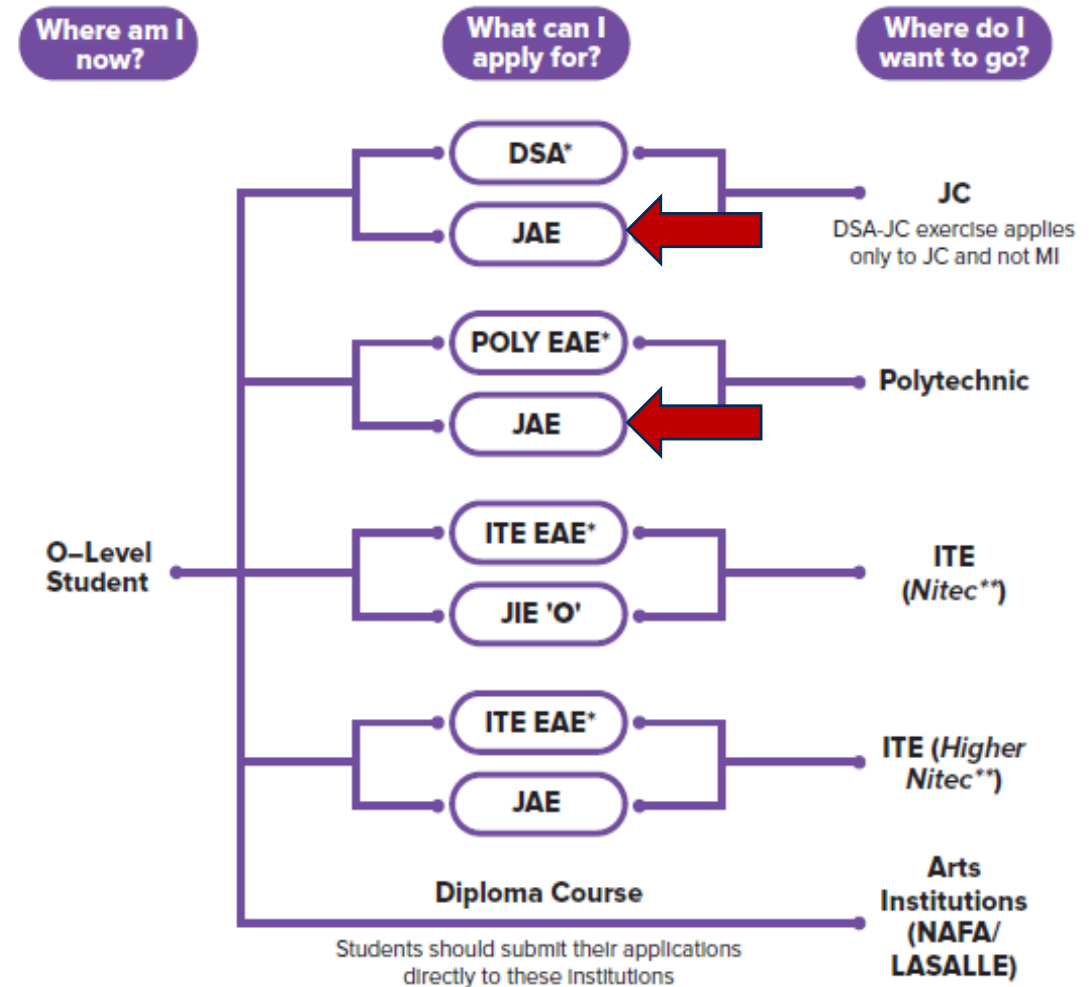
- All candidates eligible for JAE may also download a copy of Form A from the JAE Internet System (JAE-IS) during the application period.

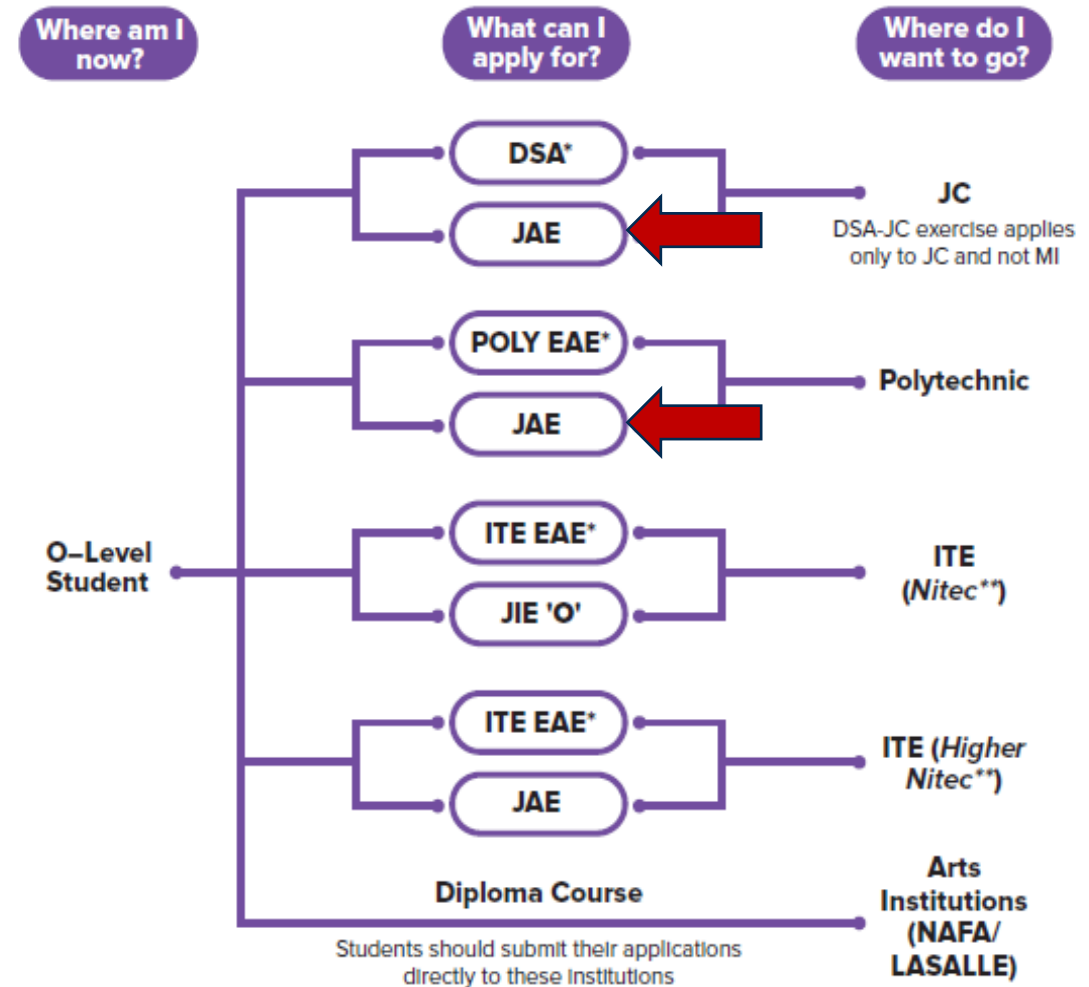

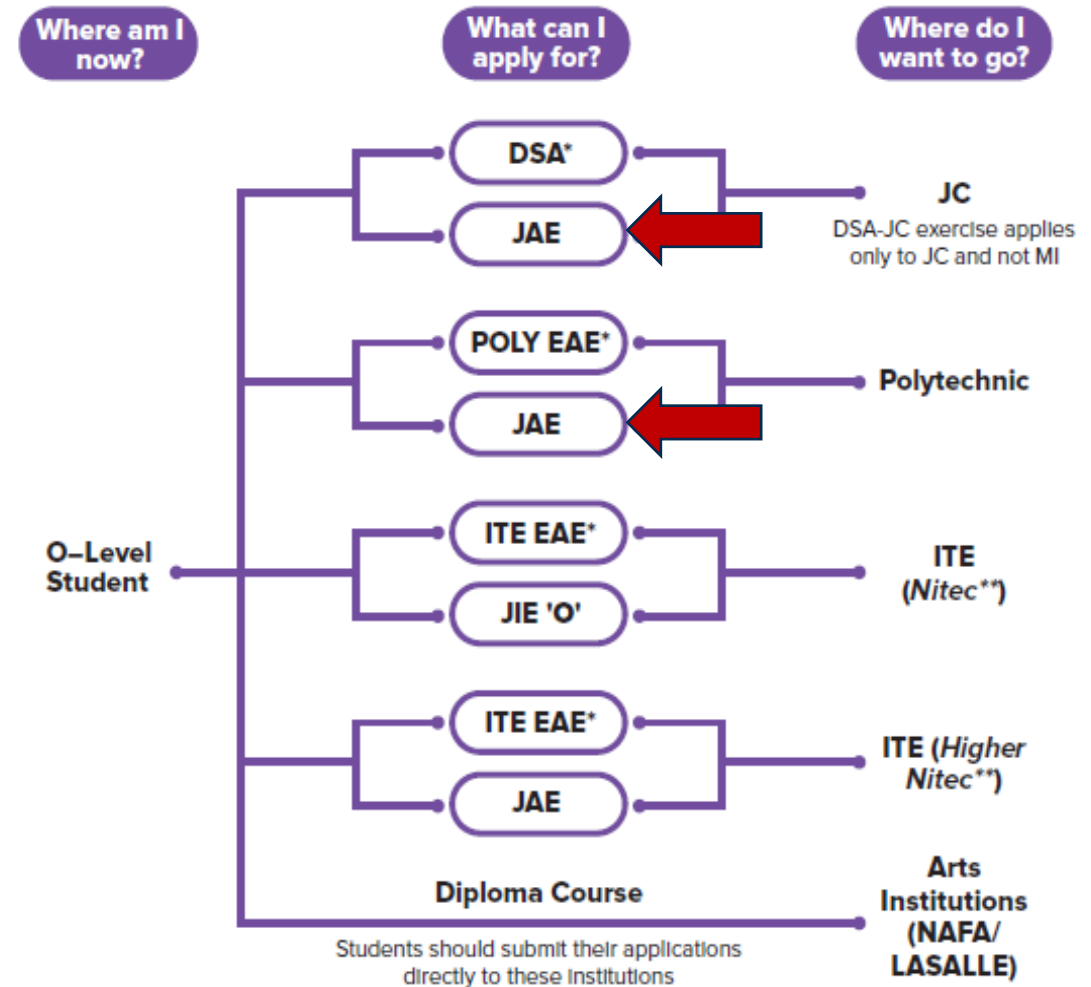

The posting results of the JAE application are scheduled for release on **Thursday, 1 February 2024** through the following modes:

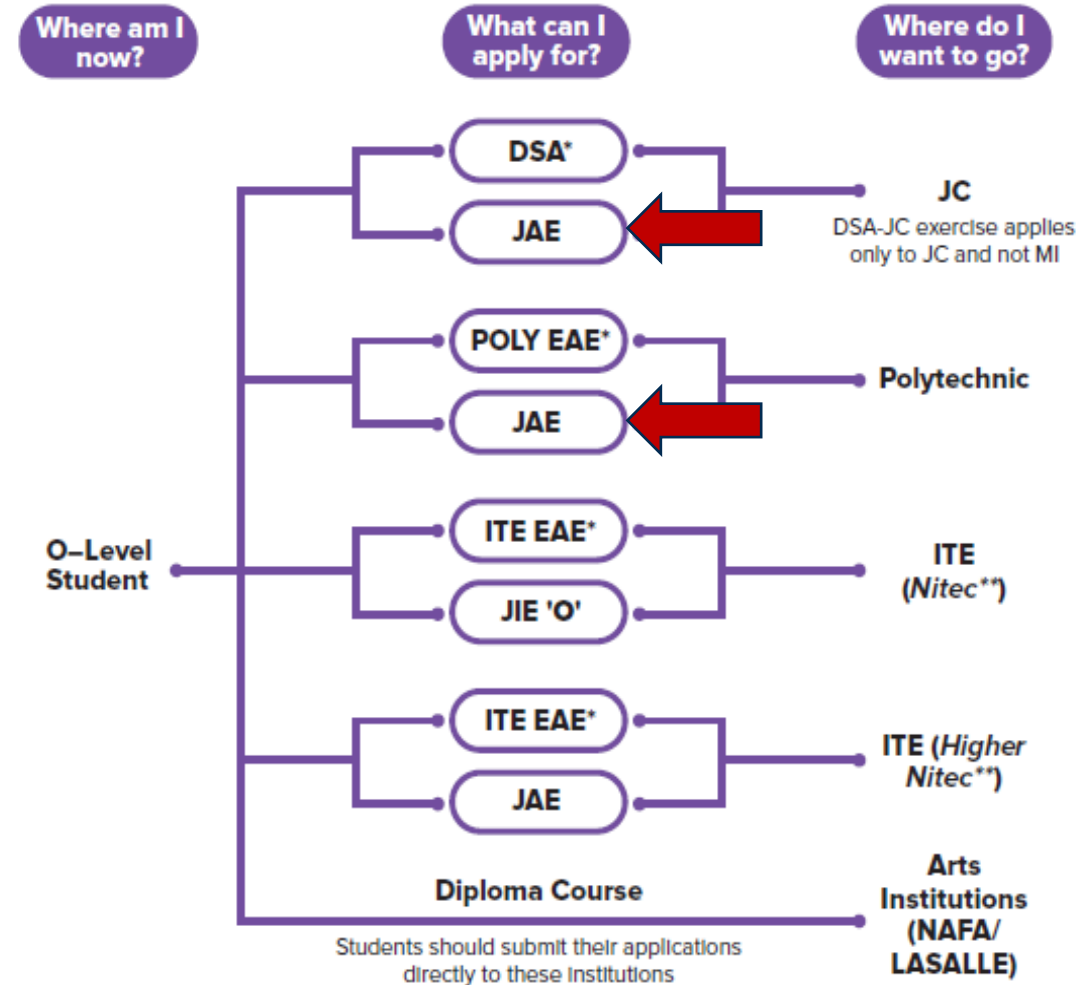

# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

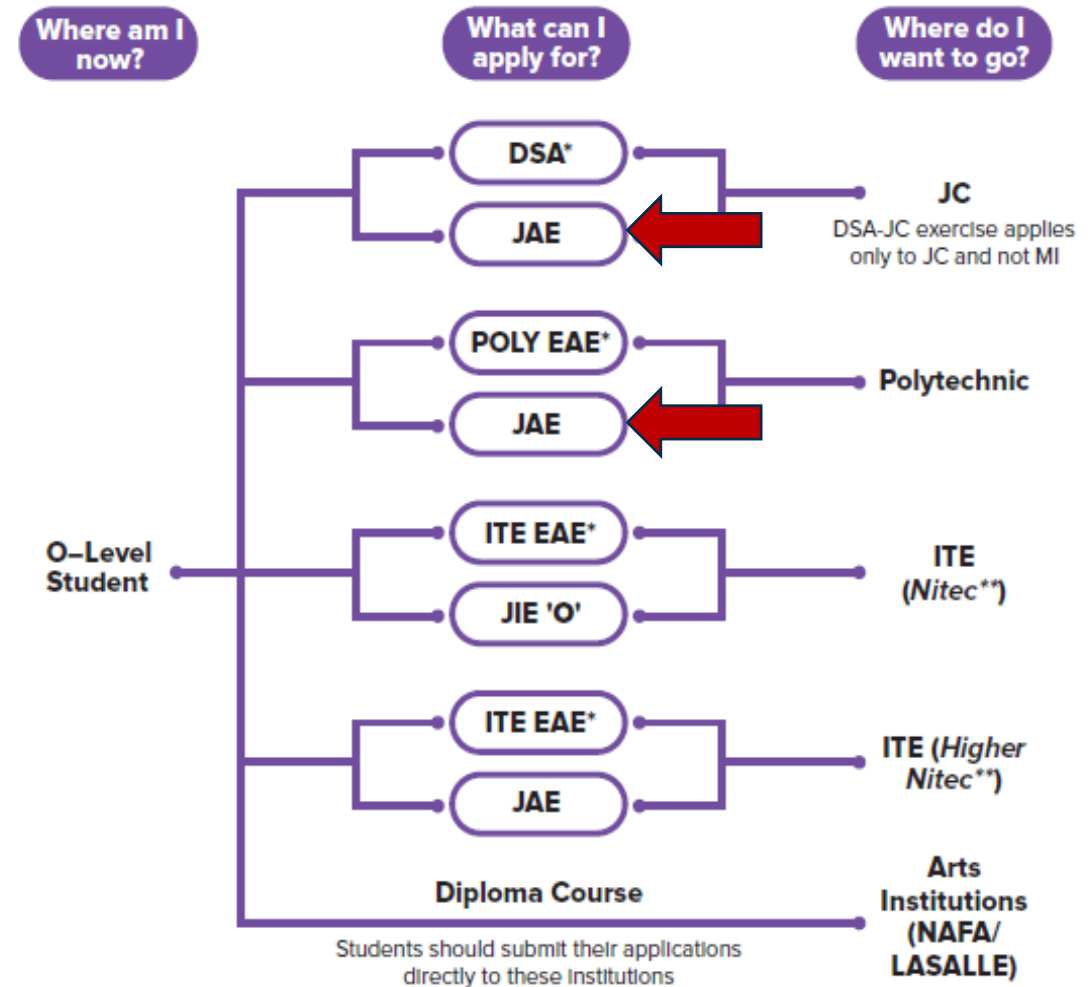
- Applicants posted to JCs and MI are to report to their posted institutions on **Friday, 2 February 2024**.
- If students are unable to report to their posted JC or MI on the first day of school due to valid reasons, they should contact their posted school directly to confirm that they are taking up the place, and the school will reserve the place for them.

## Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

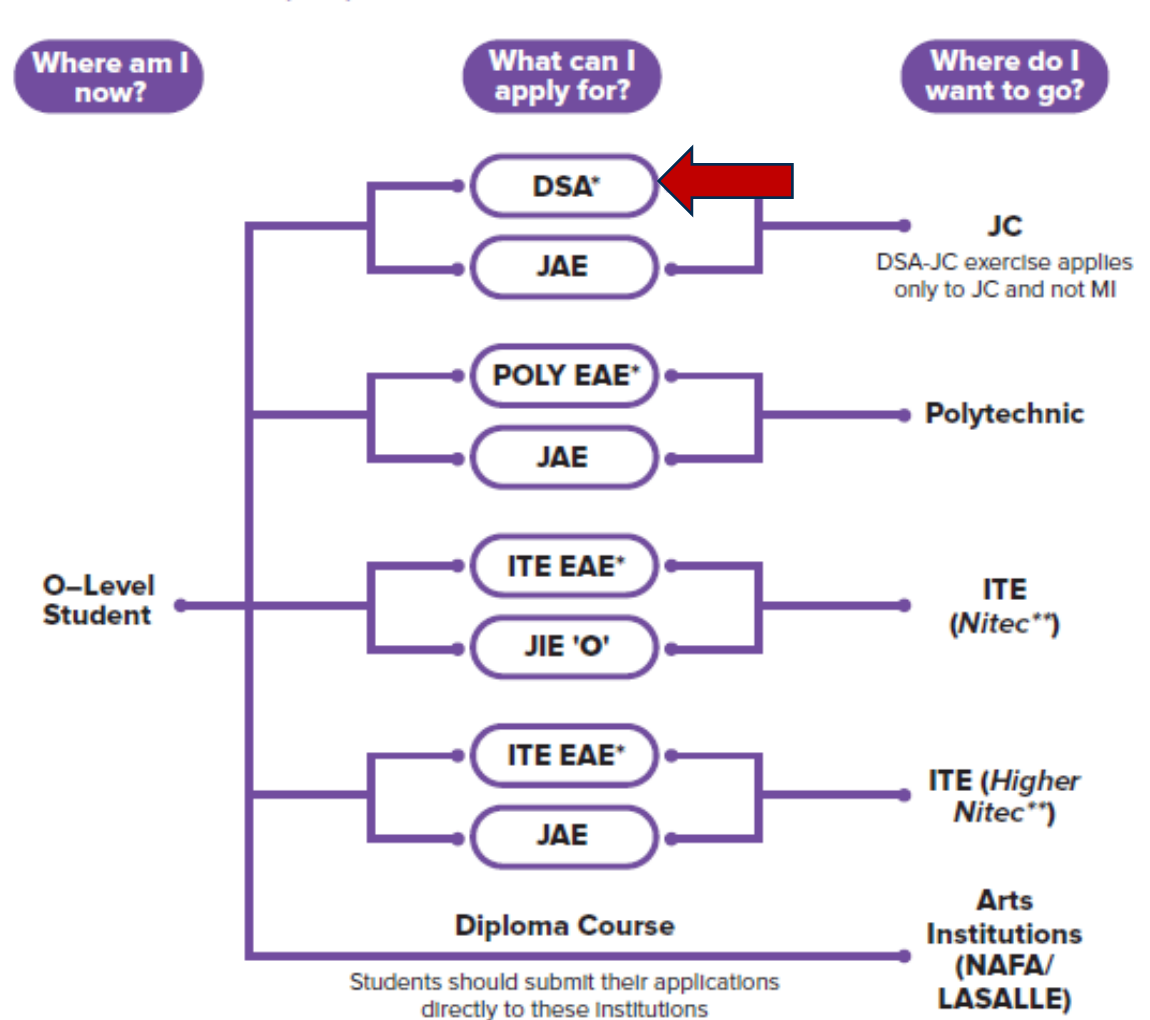
- Applicants posted to polytechnics or ITE will receive an email or package via mail on the enrolment details by end-February 2024.



# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Direct School Admission (DSA) – JCs

- Students who had accepted offers through the 2023 DSA-JC will be admitted to their chosen JC if they have met the eligibility criteria for admission based on their GCE O-Level examination results.
- Students admitted to a JC through DSA-JC will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.

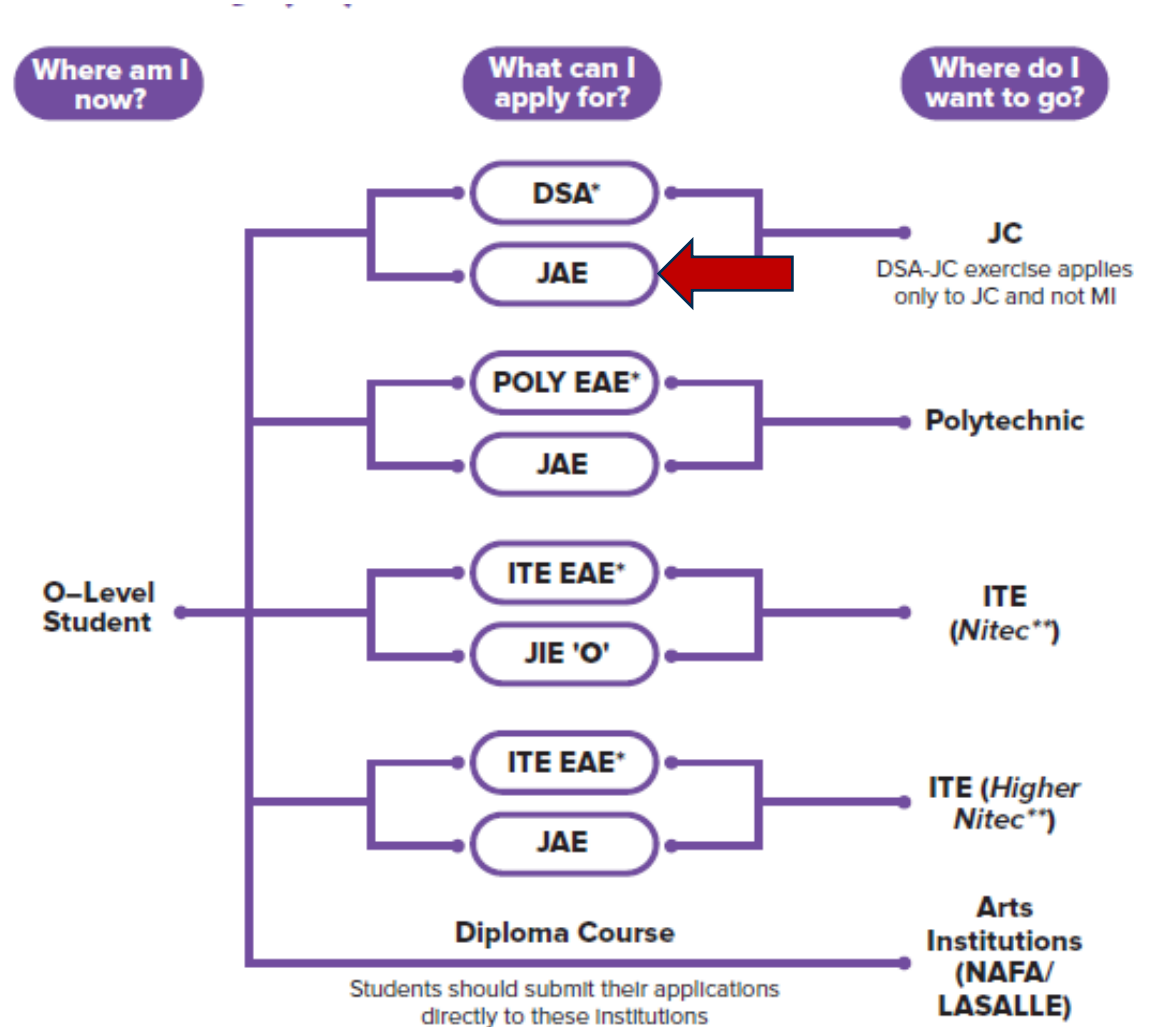




# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Direct School Admission (DSA) – JCs

- Students who do not meet the JC eligibility criteria may take part in the JAE to apply for other courses which they are eligible for.



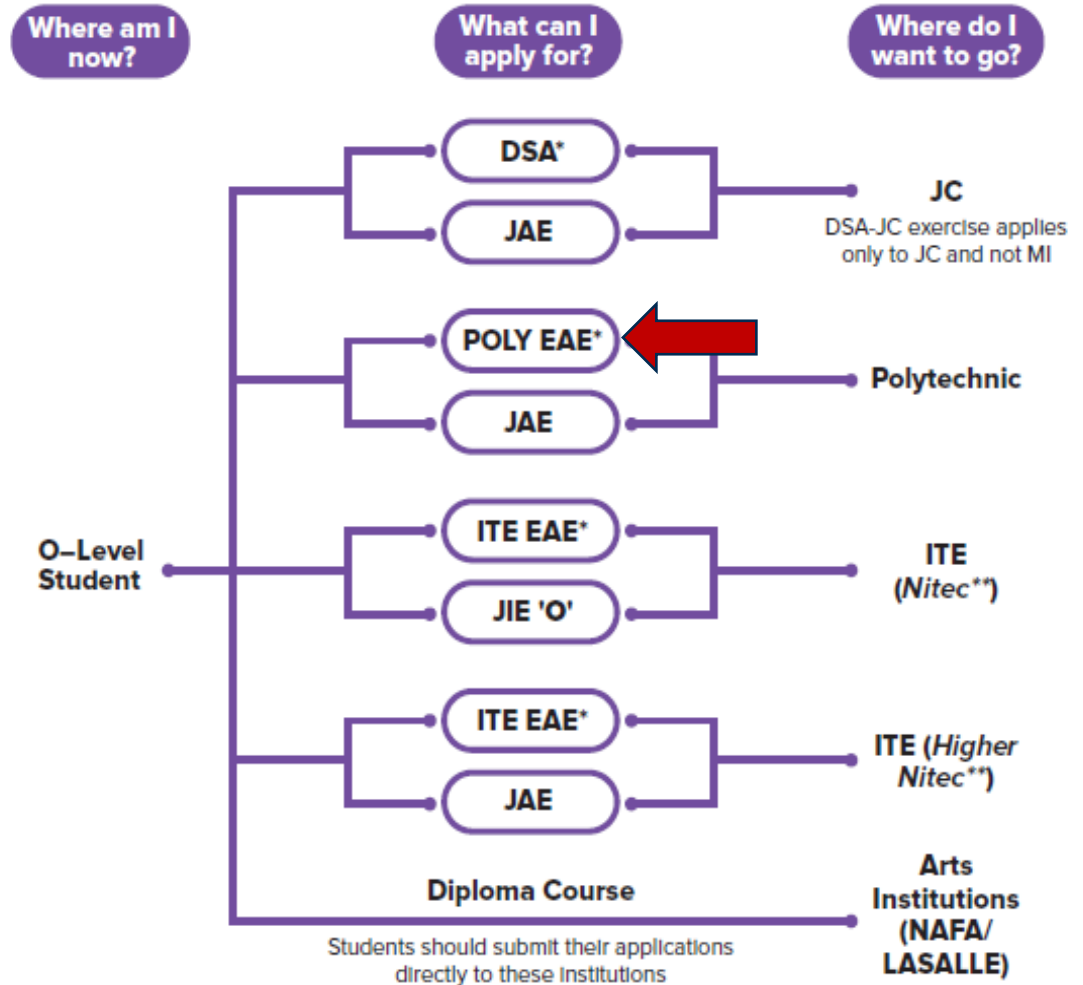


# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) – Polytechnics

Students who had earlier accepted conditional offers to a polytechnic course through the Polytechnic EAE in 2023 will have their offers confirmed and will not be eligible to participate in the JAE, if they meet the following criteria:

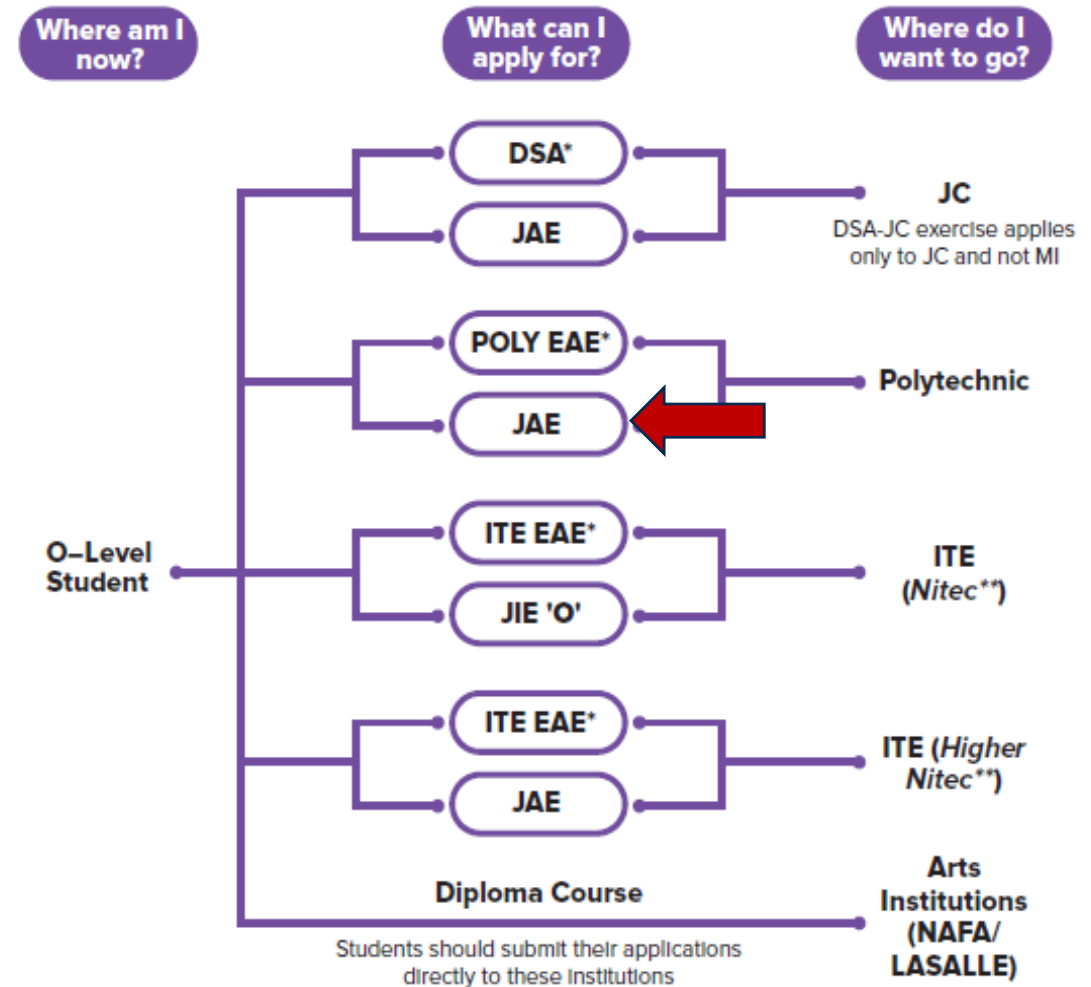
- A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or lower for the GCE O-Level examinations; and
- Minimum Entry Requirements for the respective polytechnic courses.



# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) – Polytechnics

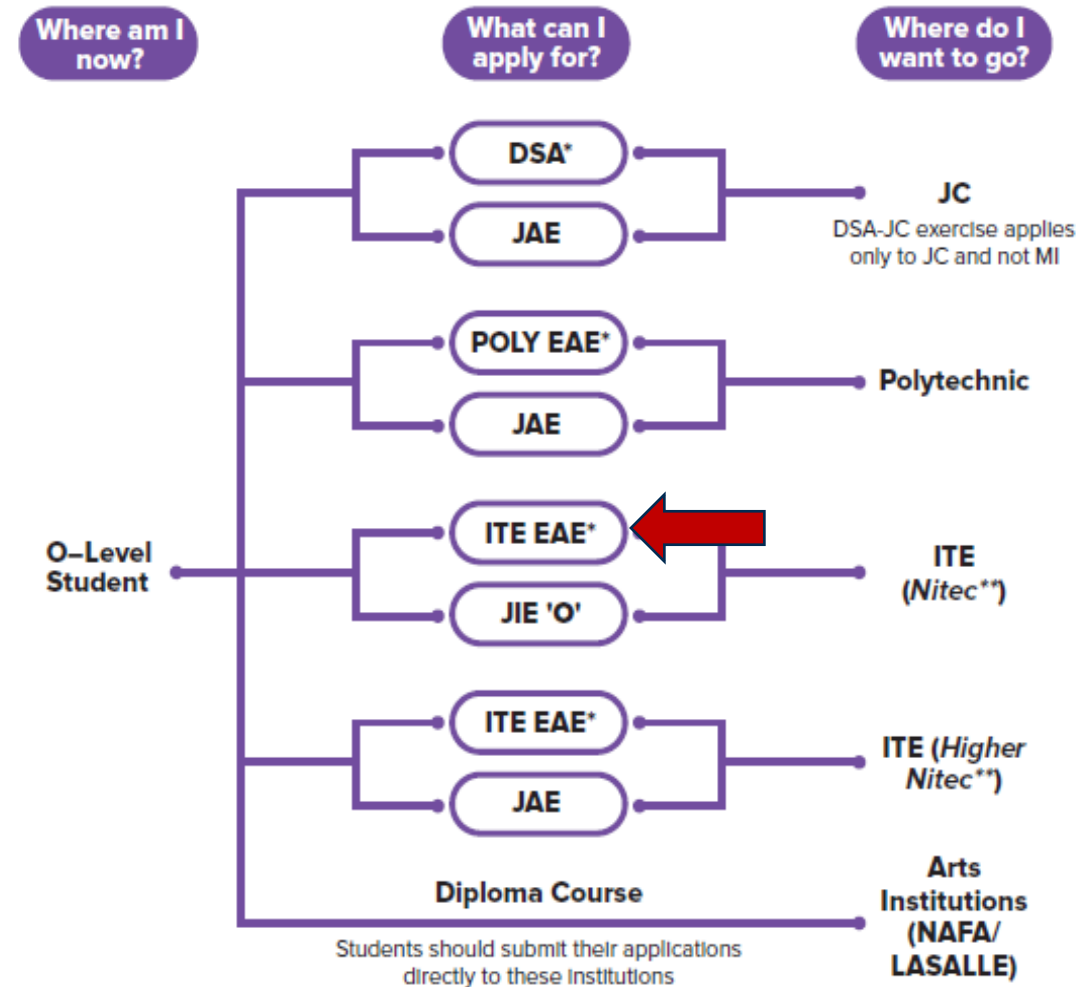
- Students who do not meet the criteria may still apply for polytechnic admission via the JAE for courses which they are eligible for.



# Admissions Exercise for O-Level students

## Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) – ITE

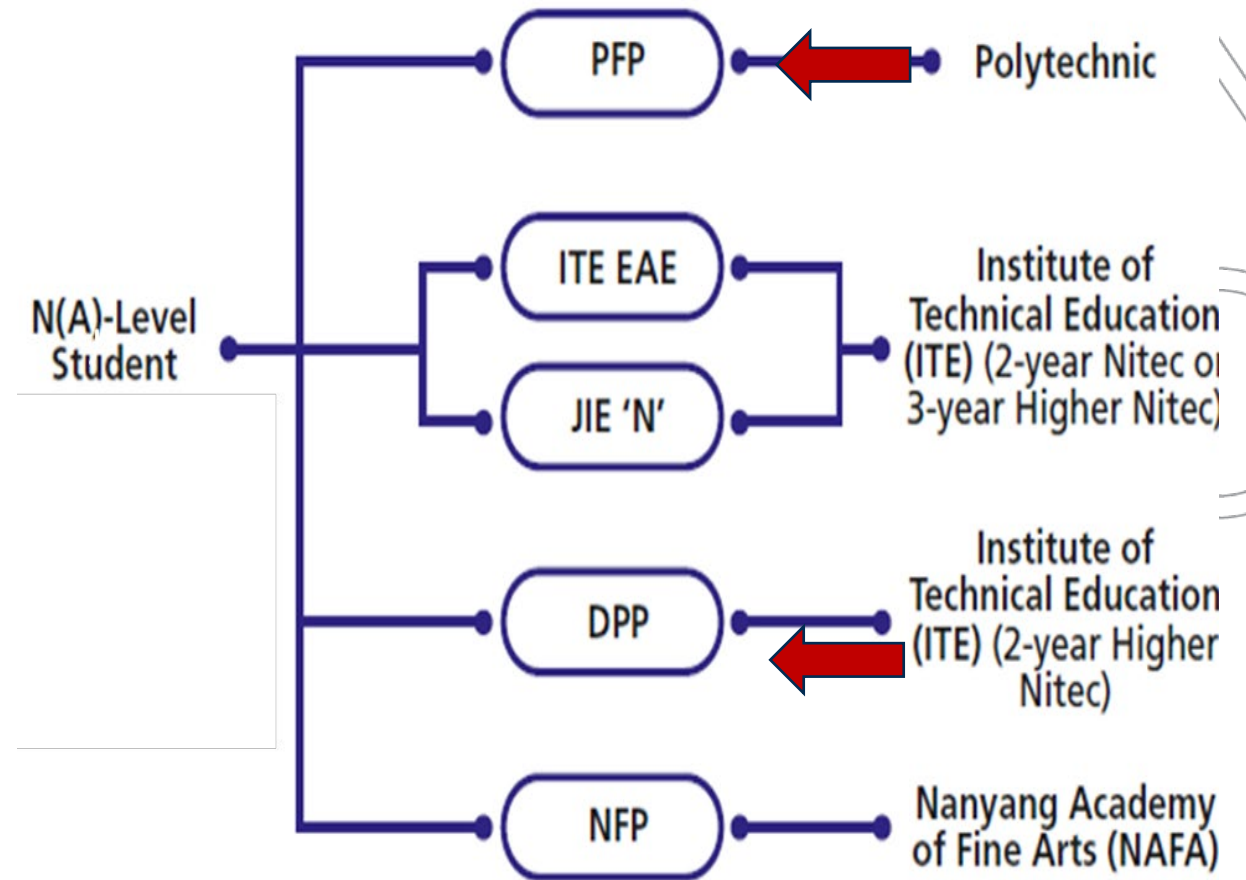
- Students who had accepted conditional offers to an ITE course through the ITE EAE in 2023 and have their offers confirmed based on their GCE O-Level examination results will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.
- Their EAE offers are confirmed if they meet the subject-specific Minimum Entry Requirements for the course.



# Admissions Exercise for N-Level students

Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) students who have sat for GCE O-Level subjects in 2023 can use their GCE O-Level results for these subjects to apply for a place in the

- Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) and
- Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).

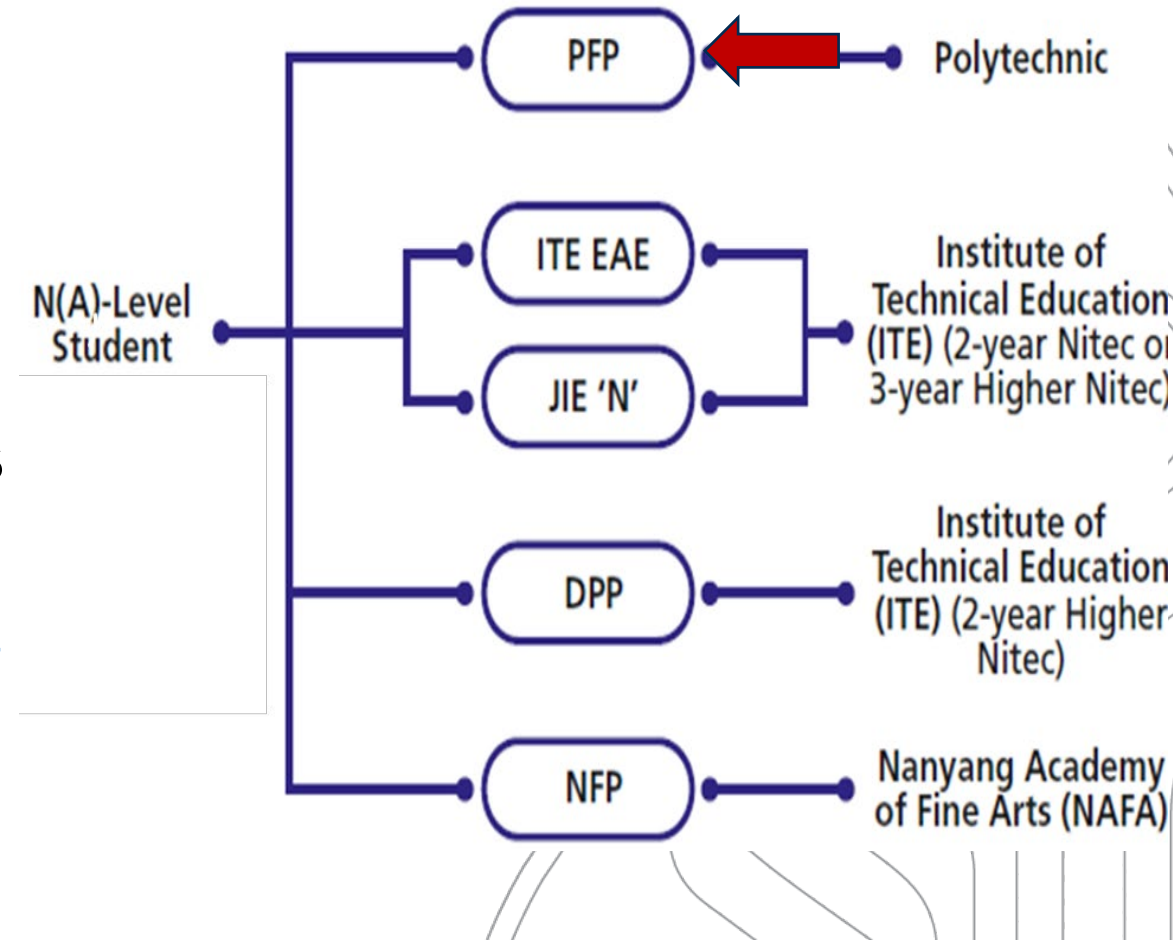


# Admissions Exercise for N-Level students

## Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

### Criteria:

- ELMAB3 aggregate score  $\leq 12$  (excluding CCA bonus points) and
- EL,MA  $\leq 3$
- Met subject-specific entry requirements stated in [https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp\\_eligibility.html](https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp_eligibility.html)

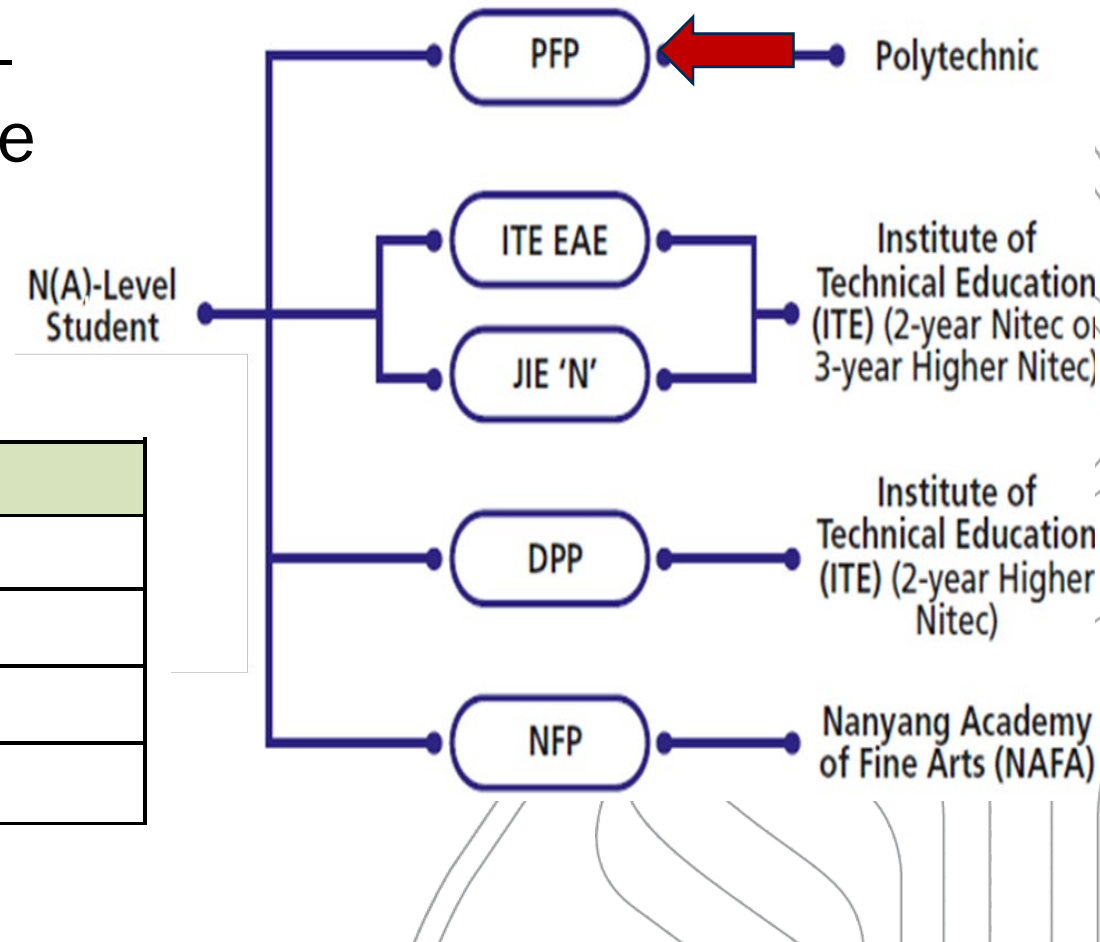

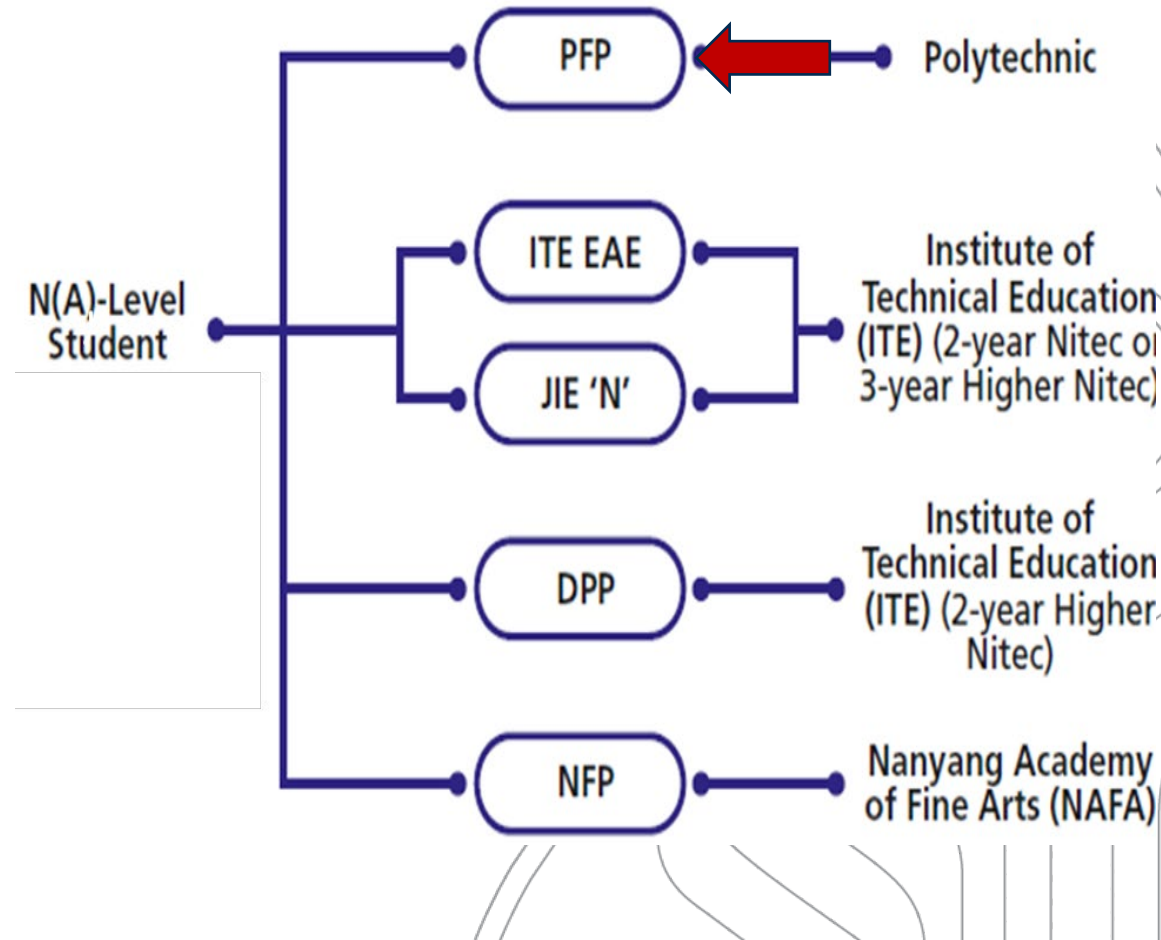

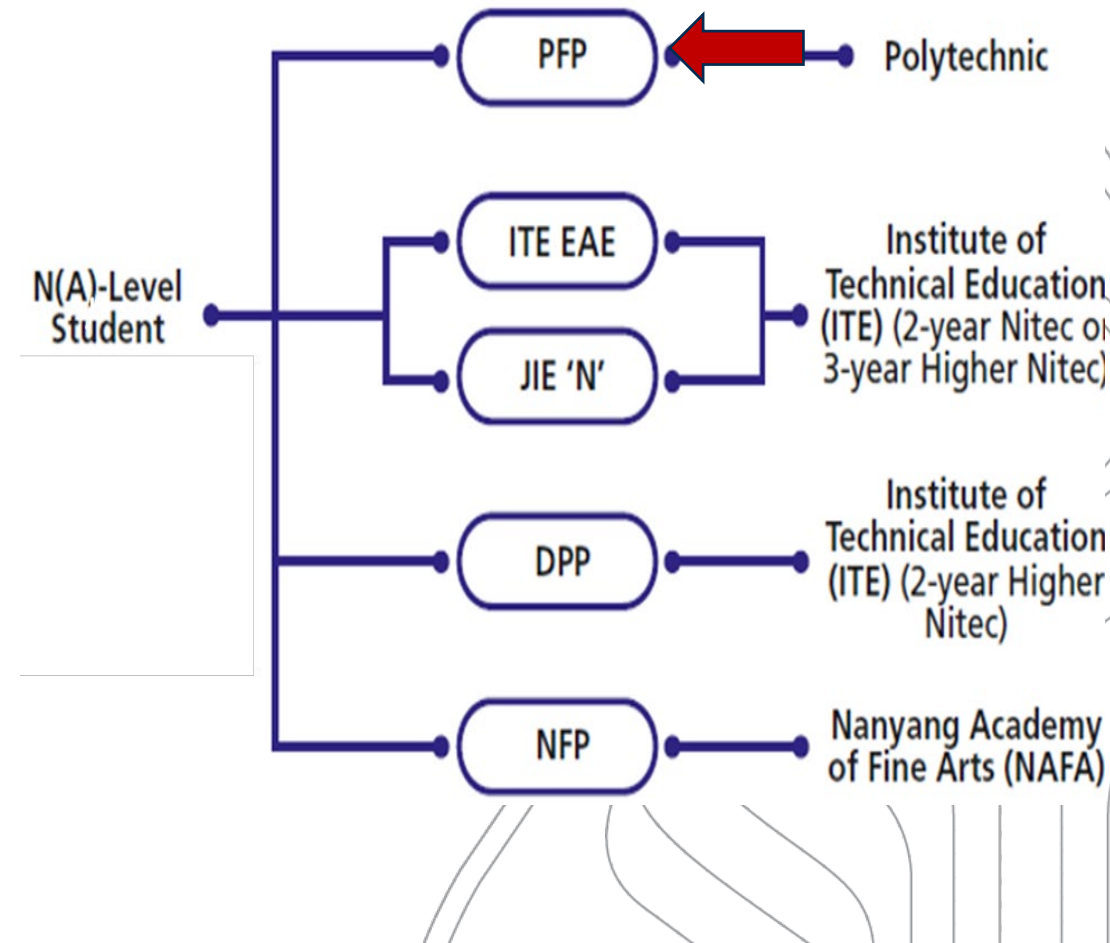
- PFP-eligible students will receive a copy of Form P from their respective secondary schools in person.

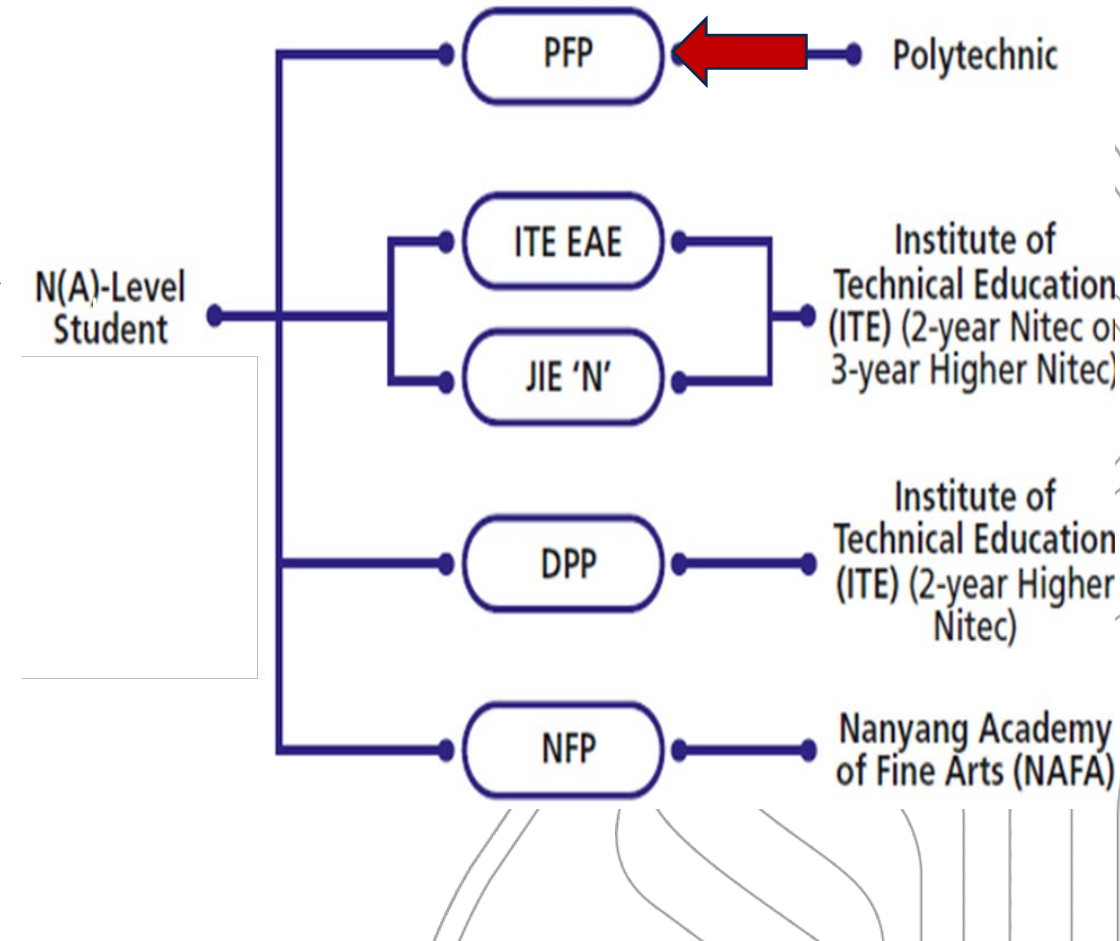

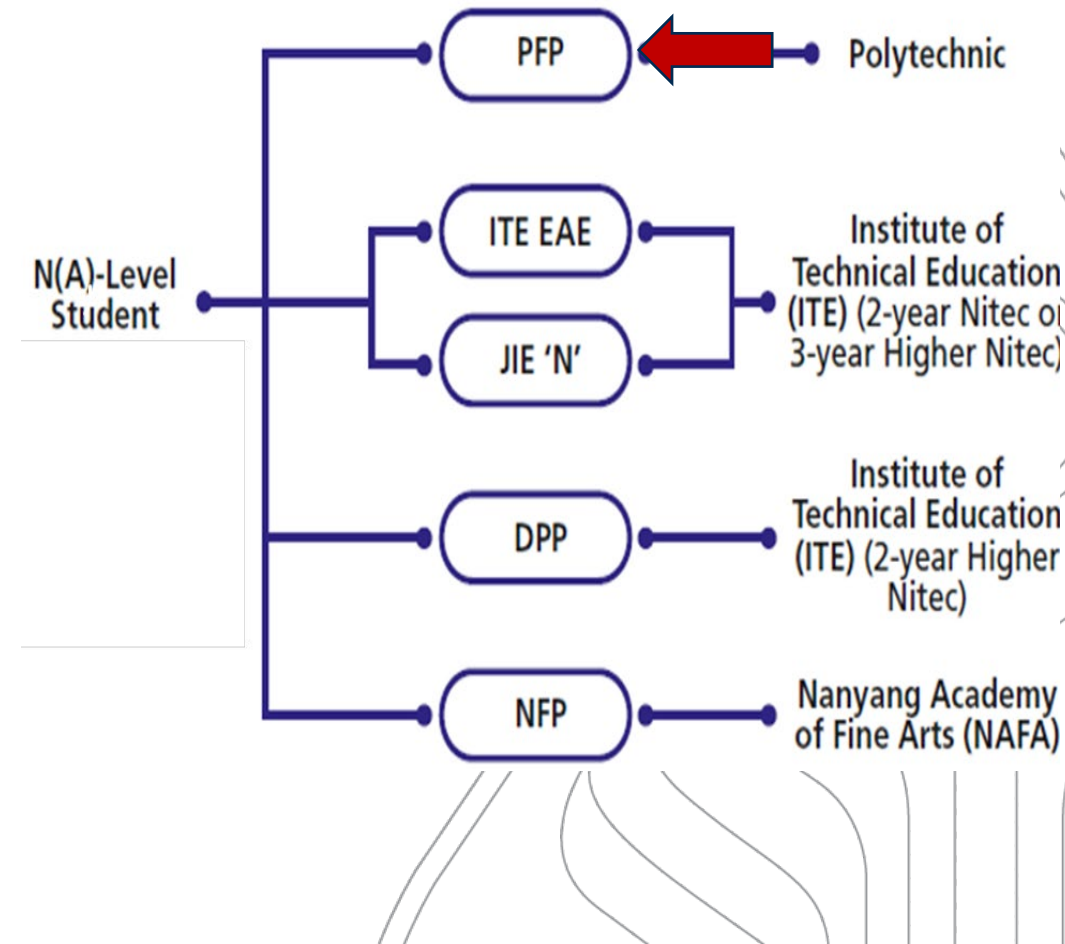

- Students will thereafter be required to indicate whether they wish to accept, reject, or appeal for a change of course by **4.00pm on Friday, 26 January 2024.**

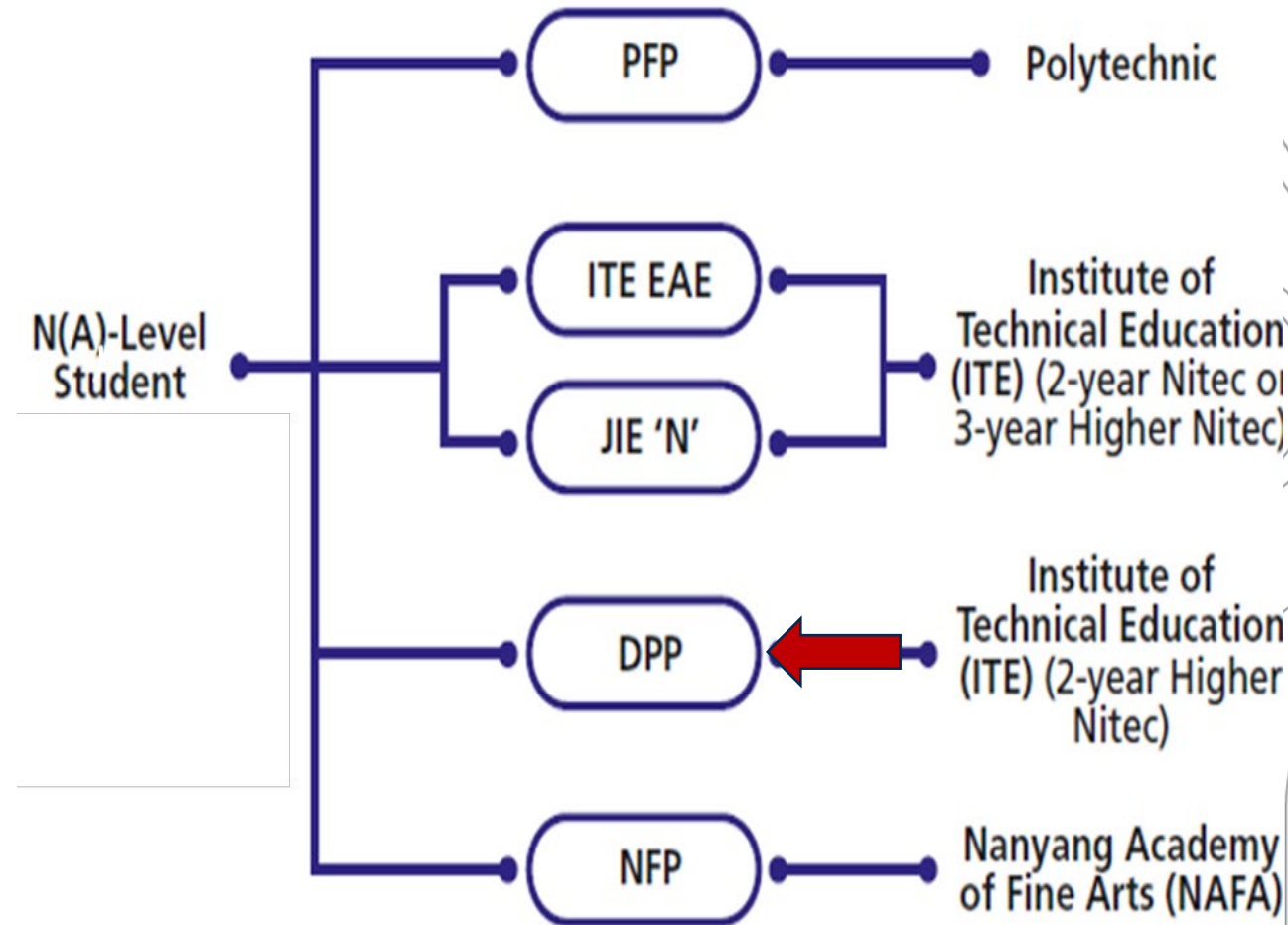

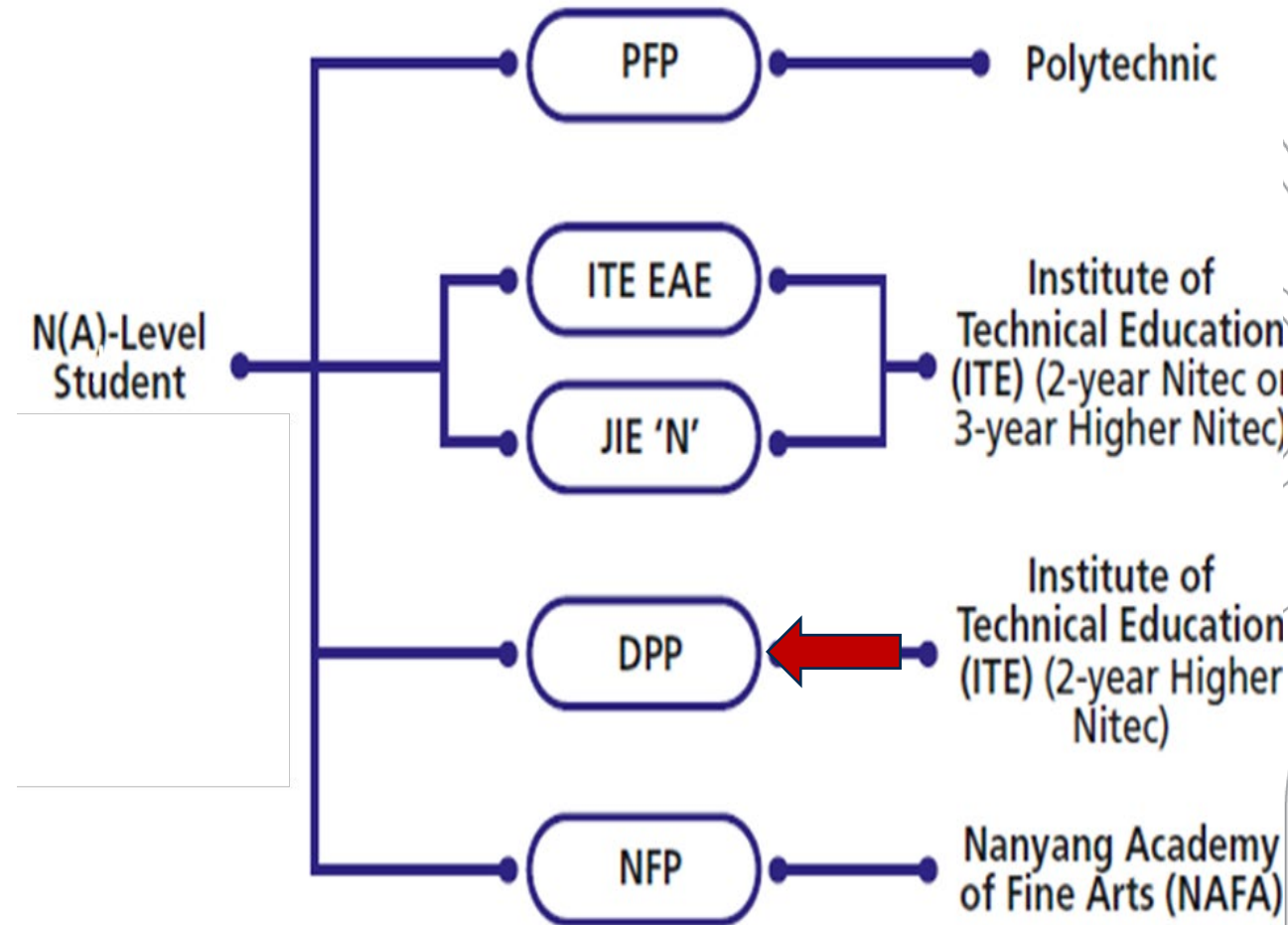

## Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

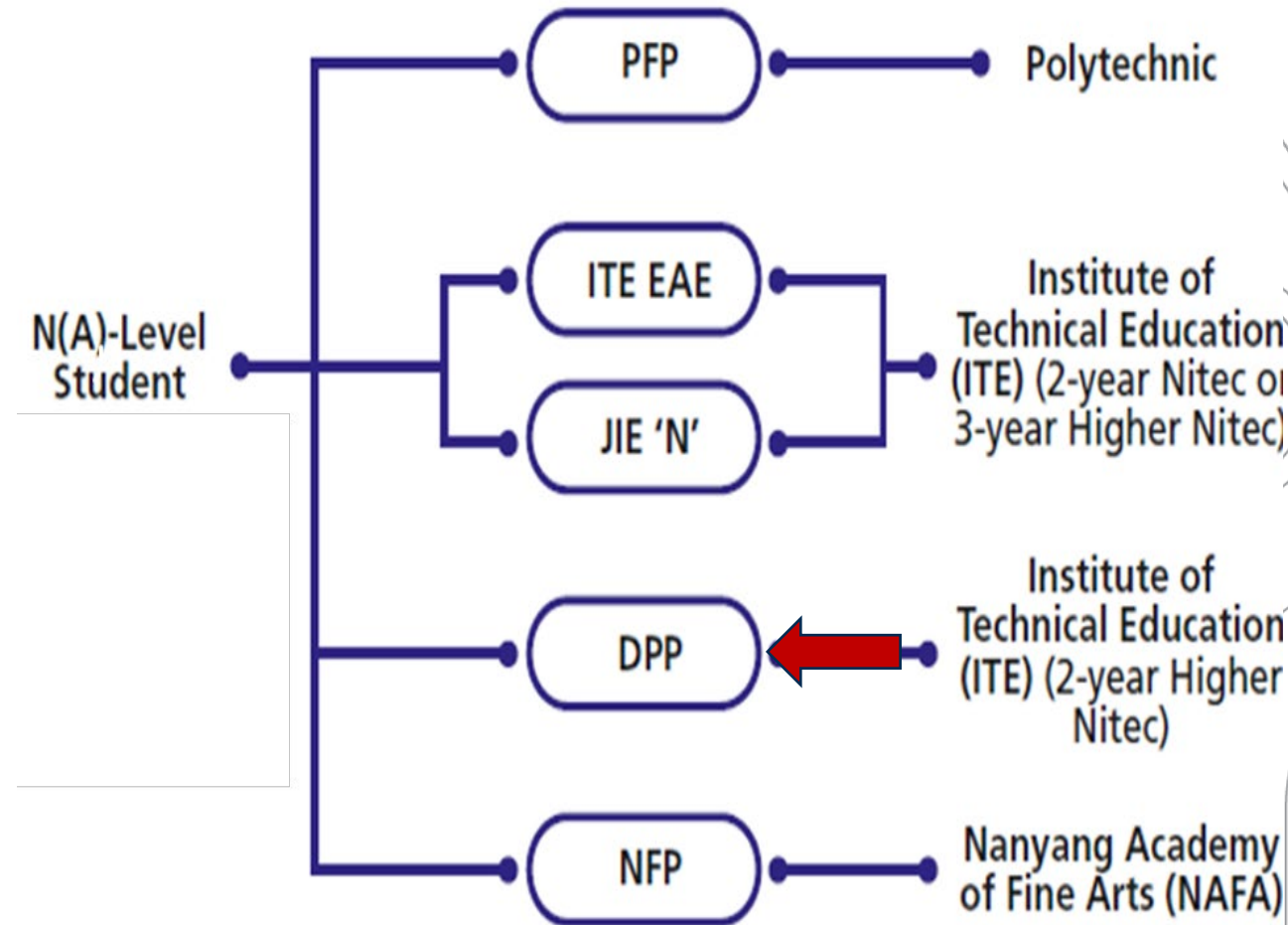
- Eligible Secondary 4 N(A) students may submit their DPP applications online via the DPP application portal at [www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses](http://www.ite.edu.sg/apply-for-ite-courses).
- Applications for the DPP will open from **12.00am on Thursday, 11 January 2024**, to **11.59pm on Tuesday, 16 January 2024**.



# Admissions Exercise for N-Level students

## Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- The DPP posting results for applications made under the final application phase will be released at **9.00am on Thursday, 18 January 2024** through the DPP application portal.
- Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer by **11.59pm on Monday, 22 January 2024**.

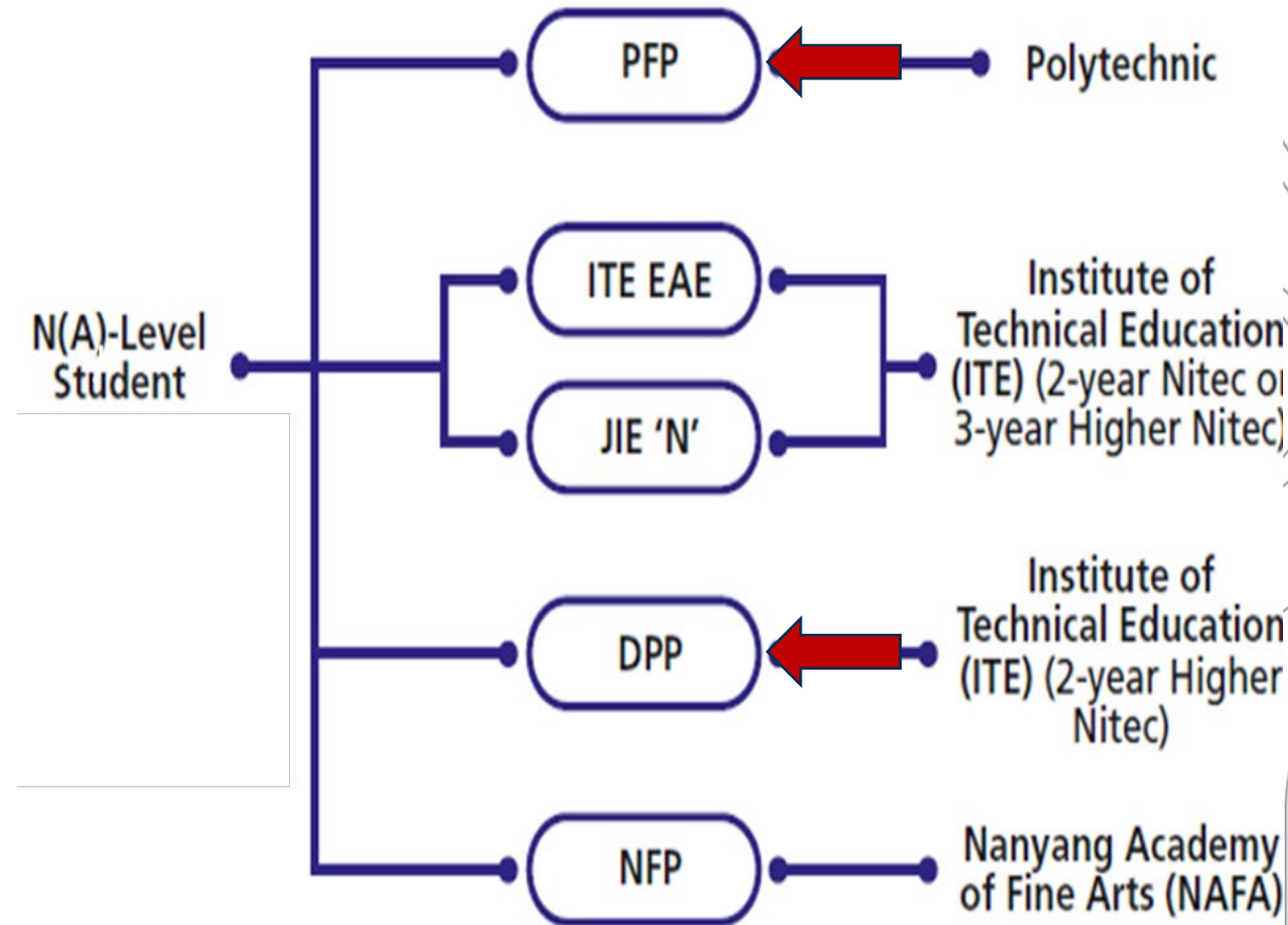

For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should report to ITE on Monday, **22 January 2024** upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.



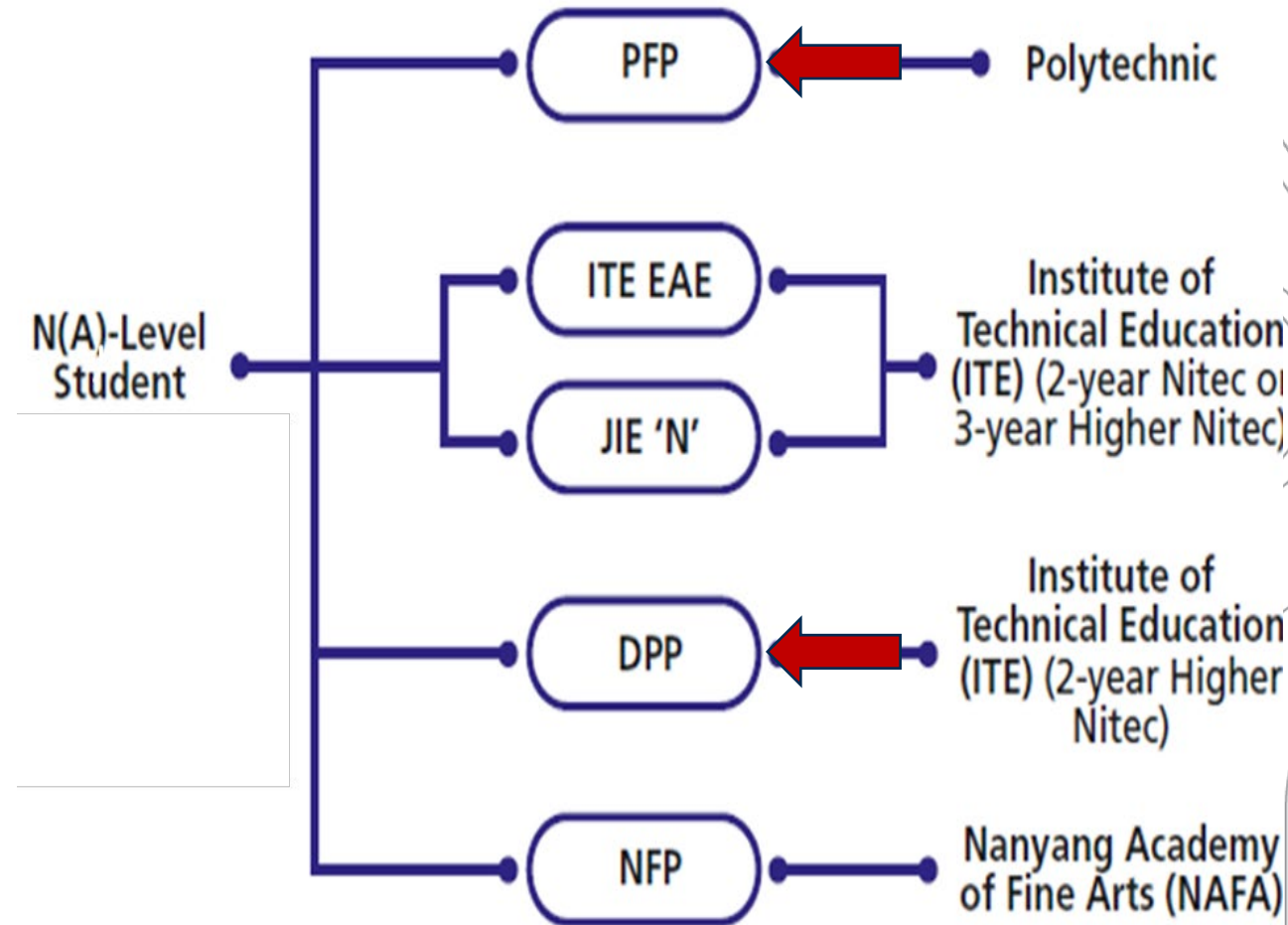
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# Admissions Exercise for N-Level students

For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

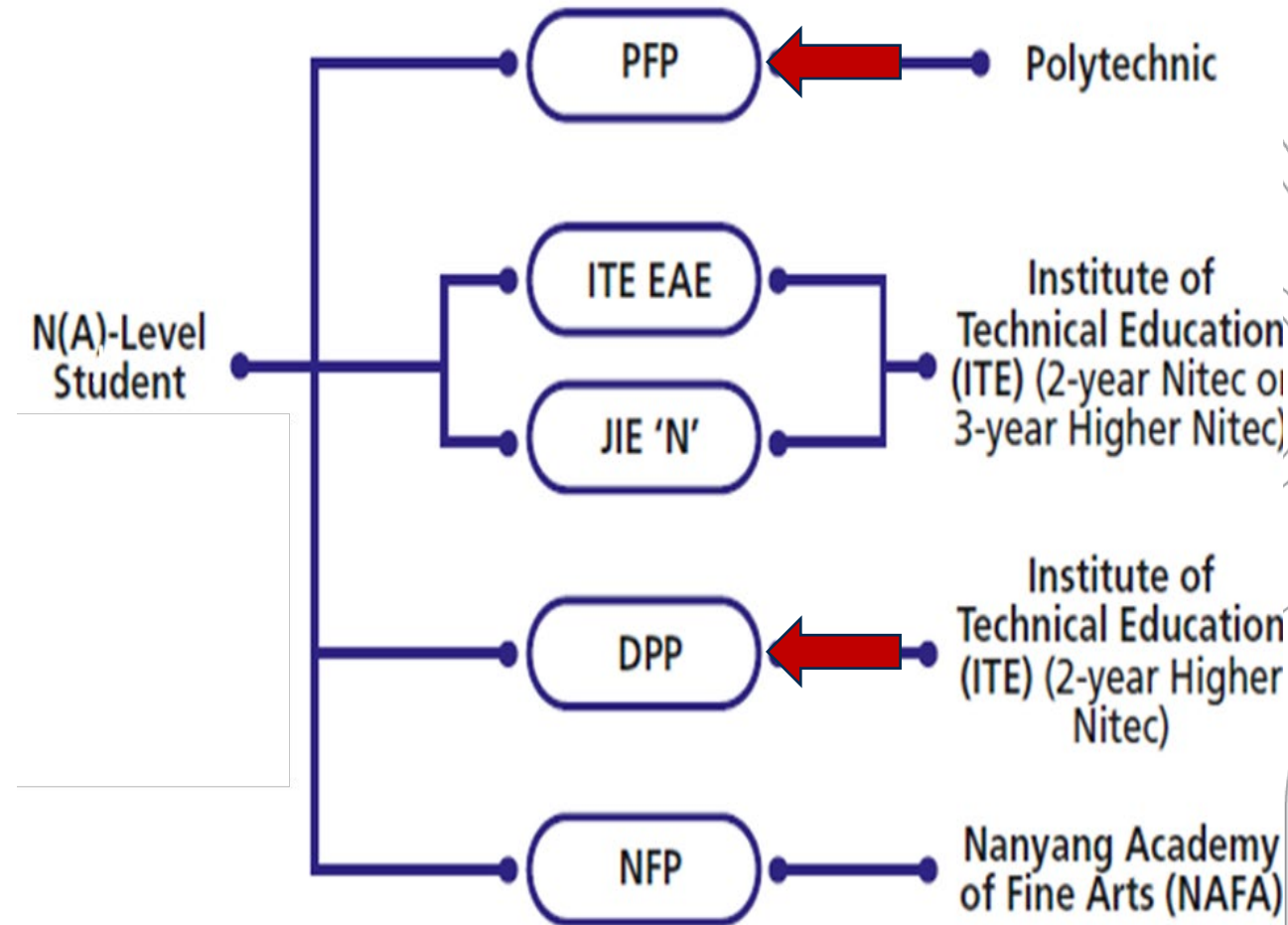
- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on **Friday, 26 January 2024**.
- Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.



# Admissions Exercise for N-Level students

## For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer.
- DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal.

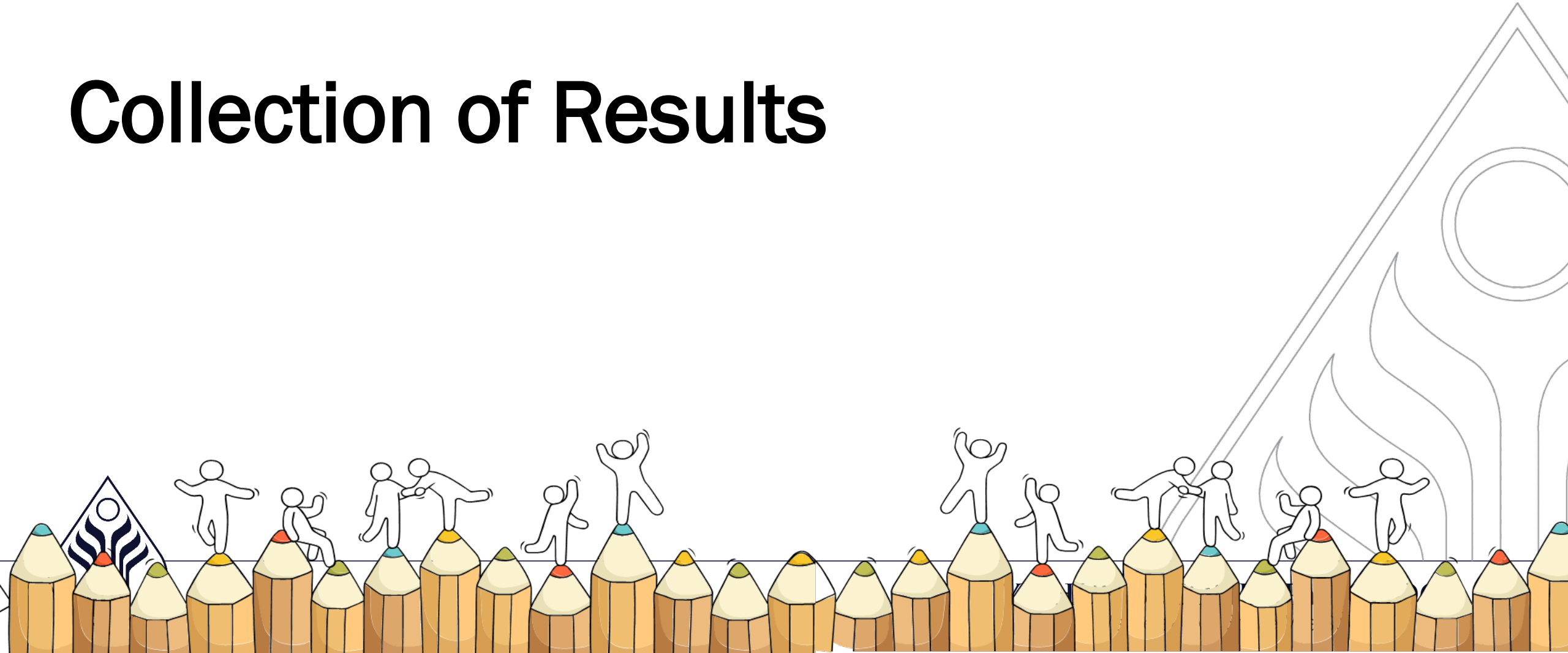

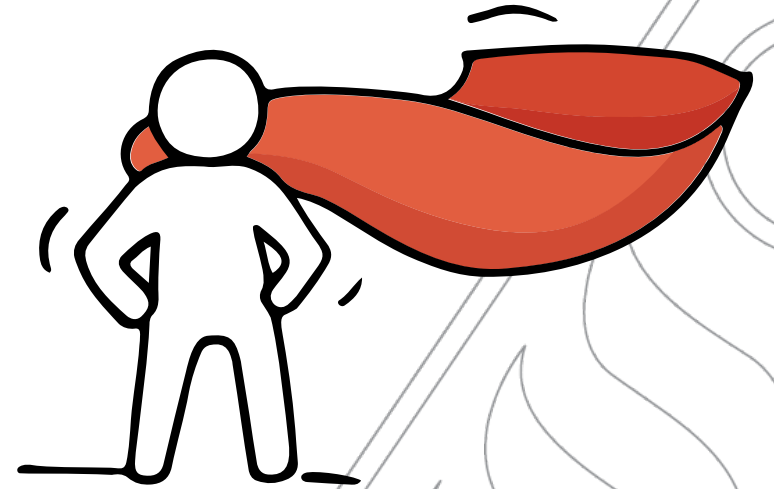


# Think Opportunities

As you await your GCE O-Level results, there are some possibilities:

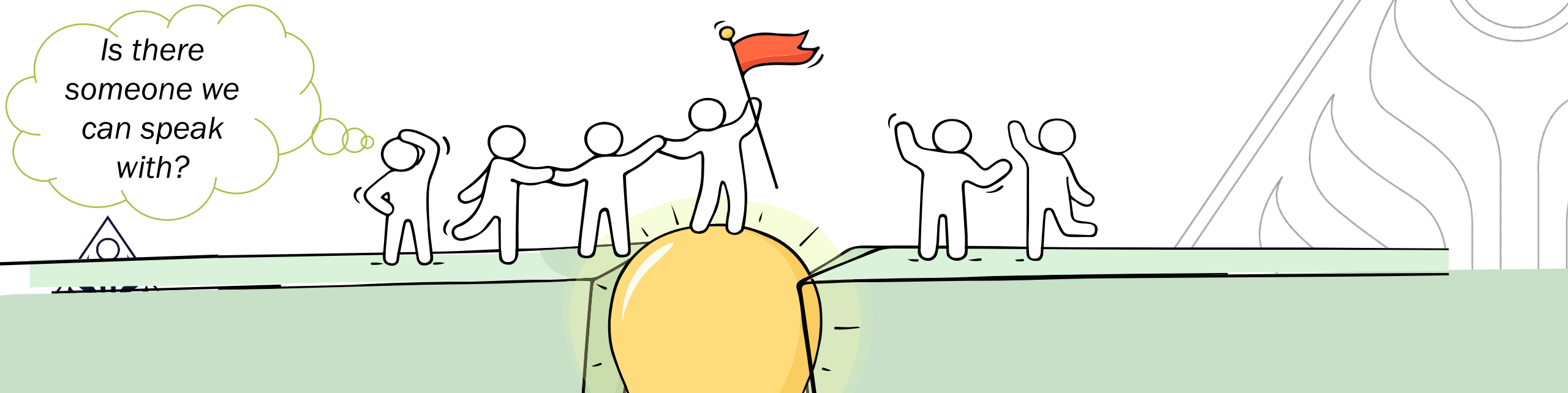
- You are happy that your results meet your expectations,
