
JIE 'N'/JIE 'E' – Joint Intake Exercise

The JIE 'N' is for students to apply for the 3-year Higher Nitec courses offered by ITE.

The JIE 'E' is for eligible GCE N(T) students to apply for the 4-year Higher Nitec course under the Enhanced Foundation Programme.

Details of Admission Exercises

DPP – Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme

DPP allows Secondary 4N(A) students to be admitted directly into selected 2-year Higher Nitec courses at ITE without having to sit for the O-Level examinations. DPP students who successfully complete their Higher Nitec courses at ITE and attain the required qualifying Grade Point Average (GPA) scores are guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their Higher Nitec course.

PFP – Polytechnic Foundation Programme

PFP is a one-year programme that offers a practice-oriented curriculum taught by polytechnic lecturers to better prepare polytechnic-bound Secondary 4N(A) students for entry into a polytechnic diploma.

Starting from the AY2026 PFP intake, students will be admitted into a PFP cluster, and progress to one of the diplomas within the cluster after completing the one-year programme.

The exceptions are Diploma in Nursing, Diploma in Early Childhood Development & Education, and Diploma in Tamil Studies with Early Education, for which students can be admitted either via the diploma-specific PFP or the relevant PFP cluster.






Information For Students on Key Dates for Jan 2026 intake

- 1. All N(A)*/N(T) school leavers are encouraged to submit an application during the 1st Phase (Main Phase) between 18 Dec 2025 (2.30 p.m.) to 22 Dec 2025 (5 p.m.). Application results for the 1st Phase will be released on 26 Dec 2025 from 9 a.m.
- 2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered <u>before</u> applying in the **2**nd **Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase)** between **26 Dec 2025 to 2 Jan 2026**. The application results for the 2nd Phase will be known on **6 Jan 2026 from 9 a.m**.
- 3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the 3rd Phase (Final Top-up Phase) between 9 Jan and 16 Jan 2026 and 22 Jan to 6 Feb 2026 for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between 12 Jan and 22 Jan 2026 and 22 Jan and 11 Feb 2026.



Option 1: Promotion to Sec 5 NA

Criteria:

- Obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less (excluding bonus points), and
- At least an N(A)-level Grade 5 for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3

Option 2: Progression to Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

What is PFP?

- The PFP is a 1-year programme that offers eligible N(A) students a practicebased preparatory pathway to a polytechnic education at one of the five polytechnics
- Instead of entering PFP for a specific diploma, you will gain admission to the PFP in 3 broad clusters:
 - Sciences
 - Humanities, Art, Media and Business
 - Design, Engineering and Technology
- NYP and TP will also offer a 'Design sub-cluster' as their design courses are more specialised, while the other polytechnics (NP, RP and SP) will offer design as part of the 'Design, Engineering & Technology cluster'.

Option 2: Progression to Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

Criteria:

- ELMAB3 aggregate score 12 points or less (excluding CCA bonus points) and EL,MA ≤ 3
- Met subject-specific entry requirements stated in <u>https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp_eligibility.html</u>



Option 2: Progression to Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

How to apply:

 Following the release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2026, eligible students may apply for the PFP online via the PFP portal at https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp application.html

Option 2: Progression to Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

Points to note for application of PFP:

- Students who are only interested in applying for the PFP should first submit application to Sec 5N(A), even if they meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on their GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2025.
- They may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2026.
- If their application is successful, they will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2026.
- All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till 31 January 2026.

Option 3: Institution of Technical Education (ITE) under Direct-Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

What is DPP?

- Consist of a two-year Higher Nitec courses at ITE.
- DPP students who successfully complete their Higher Nitec courses and attain the minimum qualifying GPA are subsequently guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their Higher Nitec course.
- Successful applicants will be required to attend a 10-week preparatory course prior to commencing their Higher Nitec courses



Option 3: Institution of Technical Education (ITE) under Direct-Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

Criteria:

- ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less (excluding CCA bonus points)
 and
- Met subject-specific entry requirements for each course, as stated in

Option 3: Institution of Technical Education (ITE) under Direct-Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

How to apply:

- Following the release of the GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2025, eligible students may apply for the DPP online via the ITE website (https://www.ite.edu.sg/secondary-school-students/ite-full-time-courses/higher-nitec-for-dpp/)
- Application opens from 18 Dec 2025, Thu (2:30pm) to 22 Dec 2025 (5pm)



Students who are interested in applying for both the PFP and DPP:

- Students are encouraged to carefully consider their interests and strengths, as well as the courses offered under both programmes.
- One option for students who are interested in both the PFP and DPP are to first progress to Sec 5N(A) and then apply for both the PFP and DPP upon release of the GCE O-Level examination results in January 2026.
- Students who are offered a place in both the PFP and DPP may only accept one course offer. Students who accept both offers will have both offers voided.
- If their application to either the PFP or DPP is successful, they will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2026.




Students who are interested in applying for both the PFP and DPP:

- For students who have already applied for and accepted their DPP offer prior to the release of the GCE O-Level examination results, their secondary school will contact them to collect the PFP eligibility form (Form P) if they are eligible for PFP after the release of the GCE O-Level results.
- Students who decide to apply for and accept their PFP offer in January 2026 will need to withdraw from the DPP course.
- Applicants can apply for a refund of their DPP enrolment fees, subject to ITE's approval.
