All parents/guardian are required to make a travel declaration if your child/ward intends to travel during the year-end holidays. Travel declaration must also be made for graduating students (Sec 4 and 5N students) who are intending to travel during the year-end holidays.

Please declare your child/ward's travel plans indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit by Friday, 30 Oct 2020. Only one parent is required to declare. No declaration is required for "cruises to nowhere".

Travel declaration can be made on Parents Gateway, please go to [SERVICE>DECLARE TRAVELS] to make your declarations. A NIL return is not required. If there are changes in your travel plans, please inform the school directly. Do continue to refer to the MOH website for the most updated travel advisory.
