School Rules

YSS Handphone Policy

Mobile phones must be switched off during school hours including recess and may only be used after school. Students are to surrender their mobile phones to the teacher before the start of the lesson and will only collect them after the lesson ends.

Mobile phones must not be used during consultation, enrichment programmes, learning journeys, CCA activities and any other school functions and activities unless authorised by teachers. Parents/guardians are to call the General Office at 68767129 if they wish to contact their child/ward.

Students are not allowed to use their phone's camera or video functions, or to access the internet during curriculum hours without the teacher's permission.

Mobile phones must not be brought into the examination room or hall during weighted assessment, school examination and national examination. All mobile phones are to be switched off and kept in the students' school bags during examinations.

Students are discouraged from bringing mobile phones to school. They are responsible for the safekeeping of their mobile phone. Student's mobile phone will be confiscated if he/she violates any of the above guidelines.

Leaving of School Premises

Students are not allowed to leave the school premises before the commencement of any after-school programmes such as CCA, consultations and Learning Journeys.

Attire and Hairstyle

Students should look neat and presentable at all times. There should be no outlandish hairstyles. Students are expected to report to school on Mondays in School Uniform for FRC. However, they are allowed to be report to school in half uniform on Tuesdays to Fridays for FRC.

Students whose attire and hairstyle do not comply with the school rules may be sent home to change. Kindly ensure that your child / ward's attire and hairstyle are in accordance with the school rules and regulations.

Secondary One Orientation Programme 2024

The CCA Open House for Secondary One students will be held on Fri, 5 Jan 2024. The CCA Open House allows students an opportunity to learn about the CCAs that are available in YSS.

The CCA Orientation will start from Term 1 Week 2. The CCA Orientation will give Secondary One students the opportunity to experience the wide range of CCAs available so that they can make an informed choice.

This year, we are happy to announce that incoming Secondary 1 girls will be able to join Football as part of the Cluster CCA initiative. In addition, Secondary 1 students may also choose to join two new CCAs, Wushu (Chung Cheng High School – Yishun Secondary School) or Pipe-band (Northland Secondary School), which are cluster-based CCAs hosted by other schools within the N2 cluster.
