Letter to Parents/Guardians - Term 1

Season Greetings to all parents and guardians! I hope this letter finds everyone well.

In 2021, we look forward to developing your child/ward holistically by continuing to provide our students with engaging and enriching learning opportunities.

Safe Management Measures (SMM)

The school continues with enforcing SMM for the term according to guidelines provided by MOE. Please refer to the SMM as stated in the previous correspondence dated 23 Dec 2020.

A gentle reminder that students who are unwell must see a doctor and stay at home. Students who have family members on HQO, SHN, LOA or MC (for flu-like symptoms) must not report to school and they must inform their form teachers of this.

Student Matters

Back-to-School (BTS) Programme 2021

The BTS Programme will end on 6 Jan 2021. Lessons will resume on 7 Jan 2021 as indicated in the timetable. Kindly ensure that your child/ward has the necessary books for lessons on that day.

Release of GCE O-Level Examination 2020 Result

The GCE O-Level Examination Result will be released on 11 Jan 2021. All students will be dismissed at 12:30 pm on that day. They are to leave school immediately after being dismissed. This is to avoid over-crowding in the school and to allow for some classrooms to be used for the distribution of result.

Secondary 4E students who sat for the Higher Mother Tongue Languages examination in 2020 and, Sec 5N (OOS) are to remain in school to collect their result.

School Reporting and Dismissal Times

Staggered reporting times will continue in Term 1: Secondary 1 and 2 students will report to school by 7:25 am, while Secondary 3, 4 and 5 students will report at 7:35 am. Lessons will commence daily at 7:50 am.

Movement in and out of the school compounds will continue to be restricted. You may drop off your child/ward as per normal in the morning. However, you will only be able to pick up your child/ward from the side gate facing Chong Pang car park (Blk 709 Yishun St 71) after school as the school gates will be locked.

Dismissal times will be staggered. Safe measures to guide students as they leave the school will be in place. There will be special designated exits from the school at dismissal time. Please refer to the information in the table below:

Gate 1 (near the Indoor Sports Hall)	For those walking home
Gate 2 (Main school gate)	No entry at dismissal time
Gate 3 (small gate beside guard house)	Closed
Gate 4 (bus-stop)	For those taking the bus home
Gate 5 (Chong Pang car park)	For those whose parents are picking them up

Please refer to your child's/ward's class timetable for information on dismissal times.

To prevent congestion, upper secondary students will be dismissed according to the time stated on the timetable, while lower secondary levels will be dismissed 10 minutes later than the time stated on the timetable for the class.

Attendance in School

Consistent attendance in school is critical in order for your child/ward to benefit fully from the learning experiences. A medical certificate will be required if your child/ward is absent from school, tests and examinations. Do note that parents' letters are not accepted unless under exceptional cases.

Co-Curricular Activities (CCA)

CCA is critical in the holistic development of your child/ward. It is essential for each student to be part of a CCA and attend all training sessions.

All CCAs will continue face-to-face sessions or online sessions as was the case in Term 4. CCAs will commence from Term 1 Week 2 (11 Jan 2021 onwards) with all the necessary safe management measures enforced.

Secondary 1 CCA Experience Programme

Our newly posted Secondary 1 students will be given more time to select a CCA of their choice.

The school has arranged for a CCA Experience Programme for them where they will view specially created videos of each CCA in YSS.

They can also sign up to immerse themselves in some of the CCAs that they might be interested in before signing up for their CCA.

The school has also organised a CCA Engagement session for parents/guardians on Fri, 15 Jan 2021 from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm. During this session there will be a briefing by HoD/PE & CCA on matters regarding CCA and this will be followed by a Q & A session where you can clarify any doubts that you might have.

Weighted Assessment (WA)

All WA will be scheduled on Tuesdays from 7:50 am to 9:10 am from Term 1, Week 3. Lessons will resume after 9:10 am. Please refer to the school website for the WA schedule.

A student who is absent for WA or examination due to illness must produce a medical certificate from a certified doctor upon return to school. The medical report/statement must clearly state the doctor's diagnosis and certification that the student is unfit to take the test.

Medical certificates without the doctor's diagnosis is considered not valid. Students who do not produce any medical certificate will be given zero mark for the paper they have missed. Medical certificates issued by Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) practitioners and letters from parents will not be accepted as valid reasons.
