- All students are expected to participate in a CCA
- All CCAs are scheduled between 4:00 6:00 pm on various days. This is to allow them to attend other school activities before CCA
- Some CCAs may require students to participate on non-scheduled dates
- Students will not be allowed to leave school before CCA
- Students are expected to be in proper attire during CCA
- Participation in 2 cluster-based CCAs (1 outside school)




INTENT OF LEAPS 2.0

Co-Curricular Experience	Basic Requirement for Level of Attainment in Domains	Bonus Points
Excellent	4,3,3,3	2
Good	4,1,1,1 3,2,1,1 2,2,2,1	1
Fair	did not meet above criteria	O



- An "Excellent" attainment will get the students 2 bonus points which can be used for admission to Junior Colleges / Polytechnics / Institutes of Technical Education (JC/Poly/ITE).
- A good CCA record will help students when they apply for DSA / EAE
- A good CCA attainment can only be achieved through active participation in CCA.



Role of Parents in the Holistic Development of your child

- Reinforcement of values, life skills, interests and strengths at home
- Encourage your child to participate and maximise the opportunities available
- Support your child in their CCA journey in YSS



CCA Experience & Selection

- Students will be given an opportunity to experience six different CCAs before making their final choices
 - Sec 1 students will get to choose and attend six different CCA choices prior to making their final CCA choice

Students will be asked to choose 6 of their most preferred CÇA

Students will be allocated to one of the 6 choices.

- Schedule and link for choosing is available through FT and SLS




Considerations for CCA Allocation
