Streaming Exercise – Key Principles

- Offering our students subject combinations that will provide them with a wide range of choices for post-secondary education.
- Streaming Exercise will be based on ability, interest and resource availability.
- To split existing classes to smaller class sizes



Streaming Exercise - Rationale for Banding

- Students will be banded based on their aptitude for Sciences (Mathematics and Science) as well as Humanities (History, Geography and Literature).
- This will serve as a guide for the streaming committee to allocate students where they can best build on their strengths.



Streaming Exercise - Ranking

- All students are ranked based on their overall percentage for all subjects
- Rank order will affect their chances of being streamed into a class of their choice



Streaming Exercise – Subject Criteria

• Some subjects require a minimum standard that students must achieve for specific subjects in their Secondary 2 examination.


