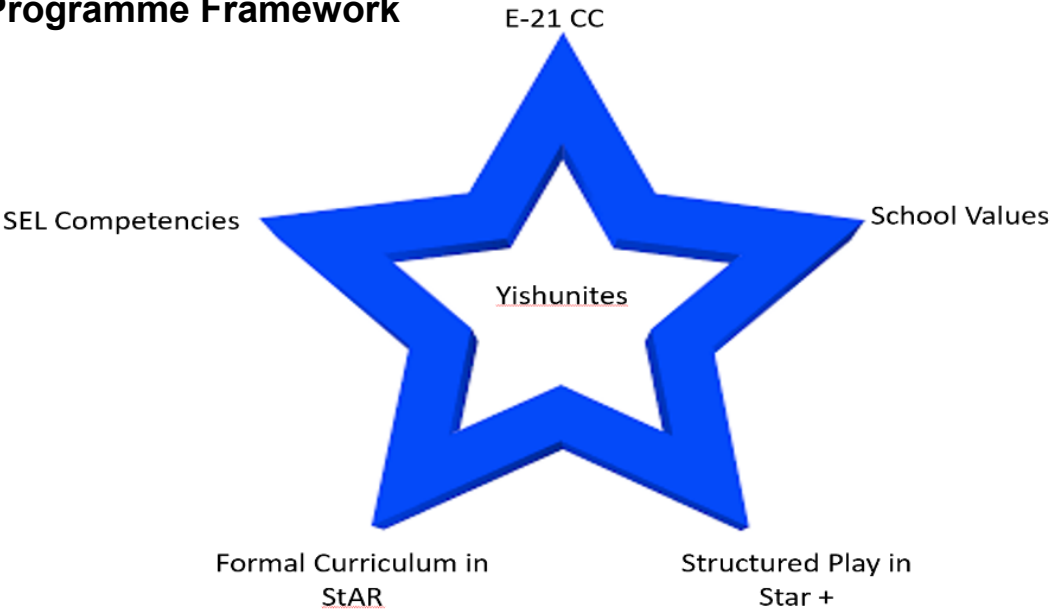

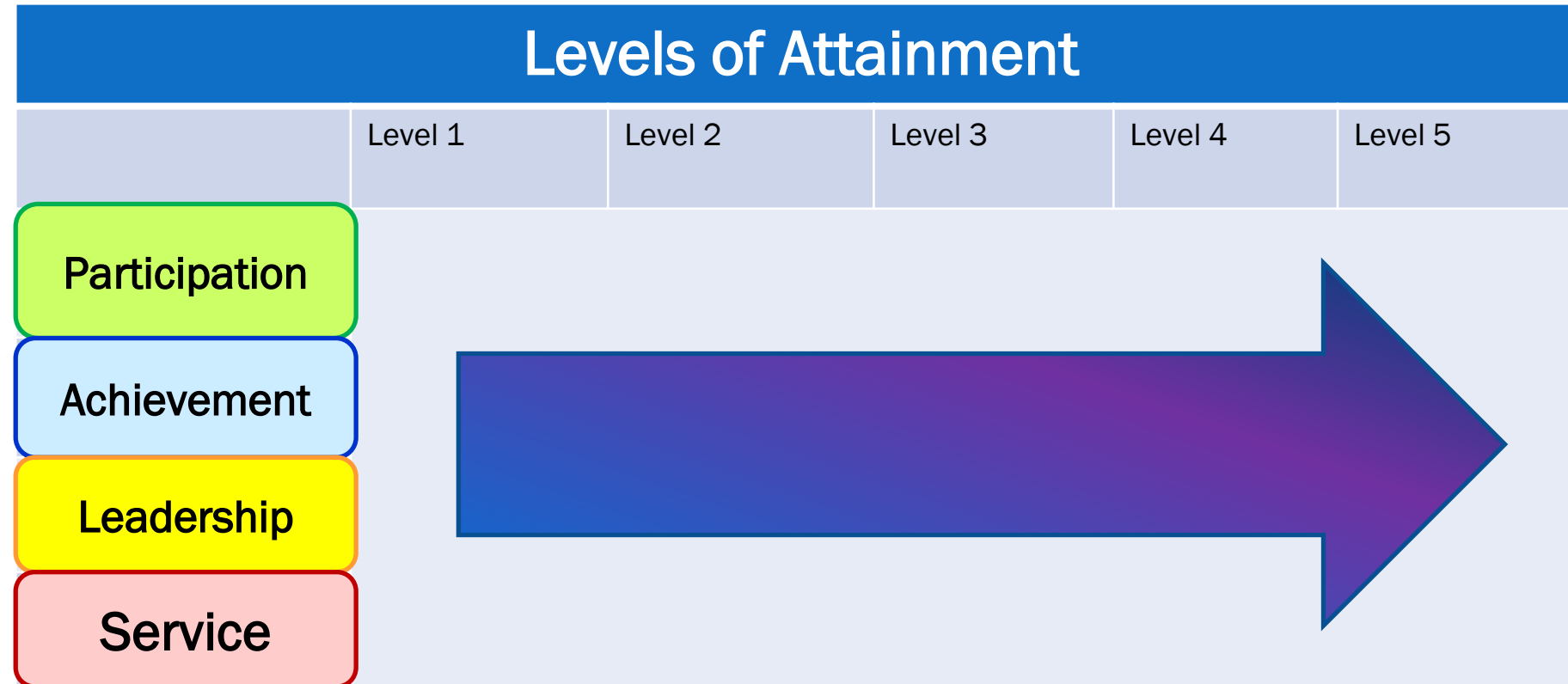

CCAs @YSS

- All students are expected to participate in a CCA
- **Less than 75% attendance will affect CCA bonus points**

- Students will not be allowed to leave school before CCA
