

Full Subject-Based Banding (FSBB)

- Students will be banded according to their aptitude and performance in all subjects, except for CCE, Physical Education (PE), and FTGP.
- Form classes will comprise students from different academic streams and subject combinations, promoting a diverse and inclusive learning environment.
- The school offers a range of subject combinations designed to provide students with broad and flexible pathways for post-secondary education.
- Subject combinations are determined based on students' ability, interests, and the availability of school resources.

CCAs @YSS

- All students are expected to participate in a Co-Curricular Activity (CCA).
- **Attendance below 75% will result in a reduction of bonus points.**
- CCAs are scheduled between 4.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on various days to allow students to participate in other school activities.
- Some CCAs may require participation on non-scheduled dates.
- Students are not permitted to leave the school premises before their CCA.
- Students are expected to be in proper attire during CCA sessions.


