#### **SCHOOL REPORT 2024**

Yishun Secondary School proudly celebrates its 39<sup>th</sup> Speech and Prize Presentation Day.

As a school and community, we celebrate our achievements for 2024. We are proud that we have continued to provide for our students the best education possible. I would like to thank all stakeholders of the school; the School Advisory Committee, the YSS Alumni, the Parent Support Group, teaching and non-teaching staff, parents, and students for working closely with the school and providing us with their continued support in 2024.

The school values of **Respect, Integrity and Resilience** are constantly reinforced in all that we do. These values form the guiding principles to achieve the Desired Outcomes of an Yishunite, **A Thinker, An Innovator, and A Contributor**. The values and the outcomes guide us as we plan a student-centric and values-based education for our students.

#### The Yishunite Experience!

At Yishun Secondary, we are proud of our unique **Yishunite Experience!** The **Yishunite Experience!** provides every student with opportunities to **Seek, Strive and Soar**. At Yishun Secondary, we believe that the true greatness in a child is founded upon the bedrock of sound values and character. We have put in place a myriad of activities and programmes that cater to our students' academic development, character development and well-being both in and out of the classroom. In Yishun Secondary, every child is important and is given every opportunity to learn, grow and flourish.

The school has embarked on Full Subject-Based Banding (FSBB) since 2020. In 2025, all Secondary 1 to 4 students are on FSBB. Students are grouped in mixed form classes and have customised timetables that allow them to study subjects at varying levels of demand.

### Strengthening 21st Century Competencies

### **Student Learning Festival (SLF)**

The Student Learning Festival celebrates student learning beyond the confines of the classroom. In 2023, the SLF started with a 3-day programme which allowed students to learn and explore concepts taught



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in the classroom in real-world contexts. For 2024, it expanded to a full week's worth of industrial visits, learning journeys to museums, heritage centres, reservoirs and even the Supreme Court.

The SLF, in tandem with teaching and learning in the classroom, strengthens students' acquisition of 21<sup>st</sup> Century Competencies (21CC) as they make connections and transfer their learning from what they learn in the classroom to what is evident in the real-world.

#### Academic Achievements

Academically our students have performed well at the 2024 GCE O-level Examination. 51% of our students qualified for the two-year Junior College/three-year Millenia Institute course and 91% of our students qualified for advancement to one of the five polytechnics.

At the 2024 GCE N-Level Examination, 68% of our students from the Secondary Four Normal (Academic) qualified for the Direct Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) while 21% qualified for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP). From the Normal Technical, 100% of our students qualified for entry into the Institute of Technical Education (ITE).

### **Academic Competitions**

Our students have performed well in academic-related external competitions<sup>1</sup>.

### **English Language**

The Queen's Commonwealth Essay Competition is the world's oldest international schools' writing competition. Each year, young people write on a theme that stems from the Commonwealth's values and principles, developing key literacy skills whilst also fostering an empathetic and openminded world view. In 2024, the focus was on 'A Youth-Powered Commonwealth', where students were encouraged to explore the power young people hold within the global community and consider how this power can be harnessed to make a meaningful impact in the world.

Sixty students from YSS participated in the competition for the first time last year and twenty four of our students received the following accolades: 12 Bronze awards, 11 Silver awards and 1 Gold award.

Forty-six students received a certificate of participation for their involvement in the <u>Live On Festival essay writing competition</u> organised by the National Organ Transplant Unit (NOTU), Ministry of Health. NOTU oversees both living donor and deceased donor organ transplants and plays a leading role in organising public campaigns and events to raise awareness on organ donation.

#### **Humanities**

Four students from YSS participated in the annual <u>NUS Geography</u> <u>Challenge</u> jointly organised by the NUS Department of Geography and NUS Geographical Society, with support from the Ministry of Education (MOE). Our students demonstrated remarkable resilience throughout the competition. Despite the intense competition, they persevered and showcased their dedication to learning and problem-solving. Their ability to adapt and persist under pressure was evident and each participant was awarded the Certificate of Participation.

The <u>Historical Scene Investigation (HSI) Challenge 2024</u>, an annual competition organised by the National Library Board and supported by the MOE's History Unit, challenges lower-secondary students to put their historical research skills to the test. This year's competition featured 117 participating schools, with students tasked to explore post-independence policies in Singapore from 1965 to 1979, focusing on how these policies shaped the lives of Singaporeans at the time and their continued impact today. Four of our Secondary 2 students participated in the challenge and secured a Silver Award.

#### **Mathematics**

Our Yishunites took part in the <u>Singapore and Asian School Mathematics</u> <u>Olympiad (SASMO) 2024</u> and were awarded 1 Gold, 4 Silver, and 9 Bronze awards, and 8 Honourable Mentions. Our Secondary 1 and 2 students took part in the <u>NIE Mathematics Challenge</u>, an online Mathematics quiz, and clinched 2 High Distinctions and 18 Distinction awards.

A Secondary 3 Express team participated in the <u>Singapore International Mathematical and Computational Challenge (SIMC)</u> where they used



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Al tools on machine learning to develop forecast models based on past results of students' examinations and presented the findings on poster during the Educators' Learning Festival.

Secondary 4 Express students took part in the <u>Math Challenge</u> at Ngee Ann Polytechnic where they had to relate Mathematics and Engineering concepts to real life situations. They won Gold Award and Silver Award for the Omega Escape and were Overall 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up.

#### **Science**

Secondary 1 students took part in the <u>STEM Playground Challenge</u> jointly held by Science Centre Singapore, The James Dyson Foundation and MOE (CPDD). The challenge required our students to create a cotton reel using simple materials like rubber bands and toothpicks. A grand total of 15,716 students from 111 primary and secondary schools participated and we emerged in the top 10 for the Secondary School Category.

The <u>Singapore Junior Biology Olympiad</u> is an annual Biology competition that pushes students to excel in the discipline by incorporating practical skills and thinking approaches in the study of Biology, and promoting critical thinking through application questions. In the 9<sup>th</sup> SJBO, two of our Secondary 4 students received the Honourable Mention Award for their stellar performance.

The <u>Genetic Modification Advisory Committee (GMAC)</u> is a multi-agency national committee committed to its task in objectively imparting scientifically-sound information on Gene Modification (GM) technology and Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs) to the public. As part of its ongoing public education efforts, GMAC organised the infographic <u>Design Competition</u> based on the theme of "What is CRISPR-Cas9 Technology and its Applications?" which two teams of Pure Biology students participated in. The competition promoted active learning in our students and stimulated students' interest in science-based GM-related topics. The teams showed commendable efforts in their research to ensure objectivity, relevance and accuracy of scientific information when designing their posters. A total of eight students received the Certificate of Participation.

The <u>16th Singapore National Crystal Growing Challenge</u> held at the National University of Singapore is a biennial event for secondary school, junior college and polytechnic students. Four of our Secondary 3 students and their teachers spent months growing crystals in the school's



Chemistry laboratory. This year, the students presented Ammonium Copper(II) Sulphate Hexahydrate crystals for the Junior Category and received the Certificate of Participation.

#### Design and Technology (D&T)

A team of three Secondary 3 D&T students won 2<sup>nd</sup> place at the <u>IDE Series Singapore Competition</u> (IDE Challenge) 2024: Fastest, Higher, <u>Furthest Competition</u>. This competition is made up of three challenges where students have two hours of problem-solving and construction time to tackle three separate construction challenges in total. In the 'Fastest' challenge, teams worked together to solve a surprise electronic challenge. In the 'Higher' challenge, teams built the tallest possible tower to support a weight provided. In the 'Furthest' challenge, teams built a bridge that is able to span the furthest between two tables.

It is the first year that our Secondary 3 D&T students took part in the <u>STEM Playground 2024 Challenge Two – "Support the mass!"</u> organised by Singapore Science Centre and James Dyson Foundation, and supported by MOE. Our student-representatives received certificates of participation in this competition which required them to construct their own cardboard chair that can support a mass of 3 kg by applying skills learnt through tinkering and learning.

The Secondary 3 Express D&T students also collaborated with Commonwealth Secondary School students during the four-session Real World Co-Design Project, a programme in partnership with DesignSingapore Council and industrial experts from Orcadesign, with support from James Dyson Foundation, to come up with innovative and inclusive solutions for target user groups. Three teams were awarded first, second and third prizes in this programme.

### **Nutrition and Food Science (NFS)**

YSS NFS unit organised the second run of the <u>Junior Chef Culinary Competition</u>, an inter-school competition, in 2024. The theme for the competition was Singaporean-flavoured pizza in which many impressive and outstanding entries from the 74 teams registered across 38 secondary schools were received. This online competition required teams to submit a photograph of the dish they had prepared in their respective schools along with a poster and the recipe. Our student-representatives received certificates of participation in this competition.



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#### **Visual Arts**

Our student-representatives received certificates of participation in the Live On Festival (LOF) – Design Competition 2024. LOF is an initiative organised by the National Organ Transplant Unit that encourages participants, in particular youths, to express their thoughts on organ donation and transplantation through art and writing. Values of responsibility, compassion and empathy are incorporated in LOF by providing insights into the delicate and emotive nature of the topic of organ donation and transplantation.

These competitions are our conscious efforts to provide our students with a platform to showcase their knowledge and skills. These awards show our students' adaptability in applying their learning beyond the classroom.

#### Innovative Awards for Students

The Endeavour Award is presented to students who have demonstrated initiative and excellence in developing their interests - whether in academics, sports, or other pursuits. This award celebrates their dedication and passion, inspiring others to cultivate a love for learning and skill development.

#### Achievements in CCA

We also celebrate the achievements of our students who have performed well in competitions bringing honour to the school and their CCA.

#### **Sports - Basketball**

Both our boys' and girls' basketball teams played heroically to bring honours back to the school. In the National Schools Games (NSG) C-Div League 1, our girls team came in 4<sup>th</sup>. In the NSG C-Div League 4, our boys' team were crowned champions.

#### **Sports - Football**

The YSS Football (Boys) team took part in the NSG C-Div League 4 and achieved 4<sup>th</sup> place.

### **Sports - Volleyball**

The B-Div girls participated in NSG North Zone Girls' Volleyball Competition and achieved 4<sup>th</sup> place.

### **Sports - Cross-Country**

Toh Jing Lun 3SE, came in 10<sup>th</sup> position at the NSG Cross-Country Competition.

### **Sports - Gymnastics**

We are proud that Tan Shang Qi, Alexis 4ST, participated in the NSG Girl's Artistic Gymnastics, B-Div and podiumed in several events. In the Vault, she claimed 1<sup>st</sup> place. For the Floor exercises, she placed 2<sup>nd</sup>. In the Beam, she claimed 3<sup>rd</sup> place. In the All-Around category, she claimed 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Alexis was also conferred the Singapore Schools Sports Council (SSSC) Colours Award.



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#### **Clubs and Societies**

Members of the Robotics Club took part in the Aerobot Challenge and were awarded the overall champions.

These achievements would not have been possible without the passion and dedication of all CCA teachers who guided and engaged the students under their care and, parents who supported the school's efforts in providing a meaningful experience in CCA.

#### Arts Extravaganza: Expressions

The Arts Extravaganza is a dynamic and inclusive celebration that offers Yishunites the opportunity to present their involvement in various art forms to the school and the broader community. This event showcases the works of students from the performing arts Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) and the music and arts students.

This year's Arts Extravaganza revolves around the theme of "Expressions", symbolising the students' ability to share their unique talents and creativity with the audience through various forms of artistic expression. The event was a great success, drawing strong support from the school, parents and members of the community.

### Going Green in YSS

YSS has demonstrated a strong commitment to promoting environmental sustainability and instilling eco-friendly values among its students. The school's efforts to create awareness on going green are impactful, earning it recognition such as the <u>Singapore Kopsia Award under the School Green Awards 2024</u> and the <u>Silver Award in the Green Living Awards 2024</u> by the North West Community Development Council.

YSS also organised its first Green community event – 'YSS Green Day at Zone H' where it aimed at promoting environmental values among students, staff, and the broader community. It was an initiative designed not only to raise awareness about environmental issues but also to inspire positive change and encourage sustainable practices.
