General Information about Direct School Admission (Secondary) 2019

The Direct School Admission-Secondary (DSA-Sec) scheme provides students with the opportunity to seek admission to a secondary school, based on a diverse range of specific academic and non-academic achievements and talents that they can demonstrate beyond the PSLE.

From 2019, application for DSA-Sec can be submitted through the online DSA-Sec Portal. The application is free-of-charge and will be opened from 8 May to 4 June 2019. For more details, please refer to MOE website – www.moe.gov.sg/admissions/direct-admissions/dsa-sec.

Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the student's aptitudes and strengths, bearing in mind the school's academic and non-academic requirements, and the programmes available to develop the area of talent.

DSA-Sec @Yishun Secondary School

All Secondary One Yishunites (Yishun Secondary School students) admitted to our school via DSA-Sec will benefit from our talent development programmes to groom them to be **leaders** in their respective talent areas. They will develop both performance and moral character through our customised programme as they grow within their respective CCAs and student development programmes.

In Yishun Secondary, the 5 talent areas under DSA-Sec are:

1. **Media:** For students who demonstrate aptitude and passion in Media, they can look forward to be part of our school's Applied Learning Programme (ALP) in Sonic Arts (Music, Media and Technology), and/or take part in CCAs such as Audio-Visual Aid (AVA) Club, Photography and Videography
2. **Music:** For students who demonstrate aptitude and passion in Music, they can look forward they can look forward to be part of our school's Applied Learning Programme (ALP) in Sonic Arts (Music, Media and Technology), Pop Music Performance and Music Creation, and/or in CCAs such as Choir, Guzheng Ensemble and Symphonic Band. Students who enter Yishun Secondary in the Normal (Technical) stream will have the opportunity to offer Music Syllabus T at the GCE N(T)-Level Examination.
3. **Cultural Dance:** For students who demonstrate aptitude and passion in Cultural Dance, they can be involved in dance performances at our school's annual performing arts showcase, *Arts Extravaganza*, as well as be part of school's cultural dance CCAs such as Chinese Dance, Malay Dance or Indian Dance.

4. **Drama-English:** For students who demonstrate aptitude and passion in Drama, they can participate in script writing workshops, gain exposure to different theatre forms, and be part of our D'Lite Club (English Drama CCA)
5. **Basketball:** For students who demonstrate aptitude and passion in Basketball, they can look forward to planning and organising intra and inter school programmes, participate in National School Games, as well as overseas school Community Youth Leadership programme.

Our selection criteria, in general, are as follows:

- Interest and Passion: Applicants should demonstrate a keen interest in and passion for their respective talent areas
- Talent and Aptitude: Applicants should demonstrate evidence of talent and/or aptitude in their talent area
- Conduct and Attitude for Learning: Applicants should demonstrate evidence of good conduct in school, as well as a positive attitude for learning and demeanour
