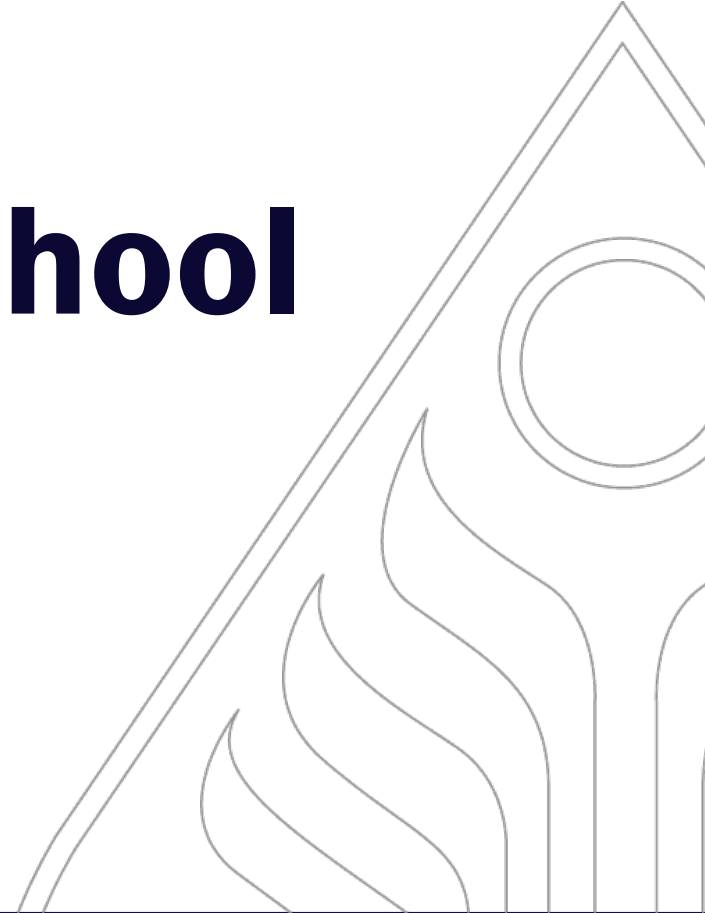

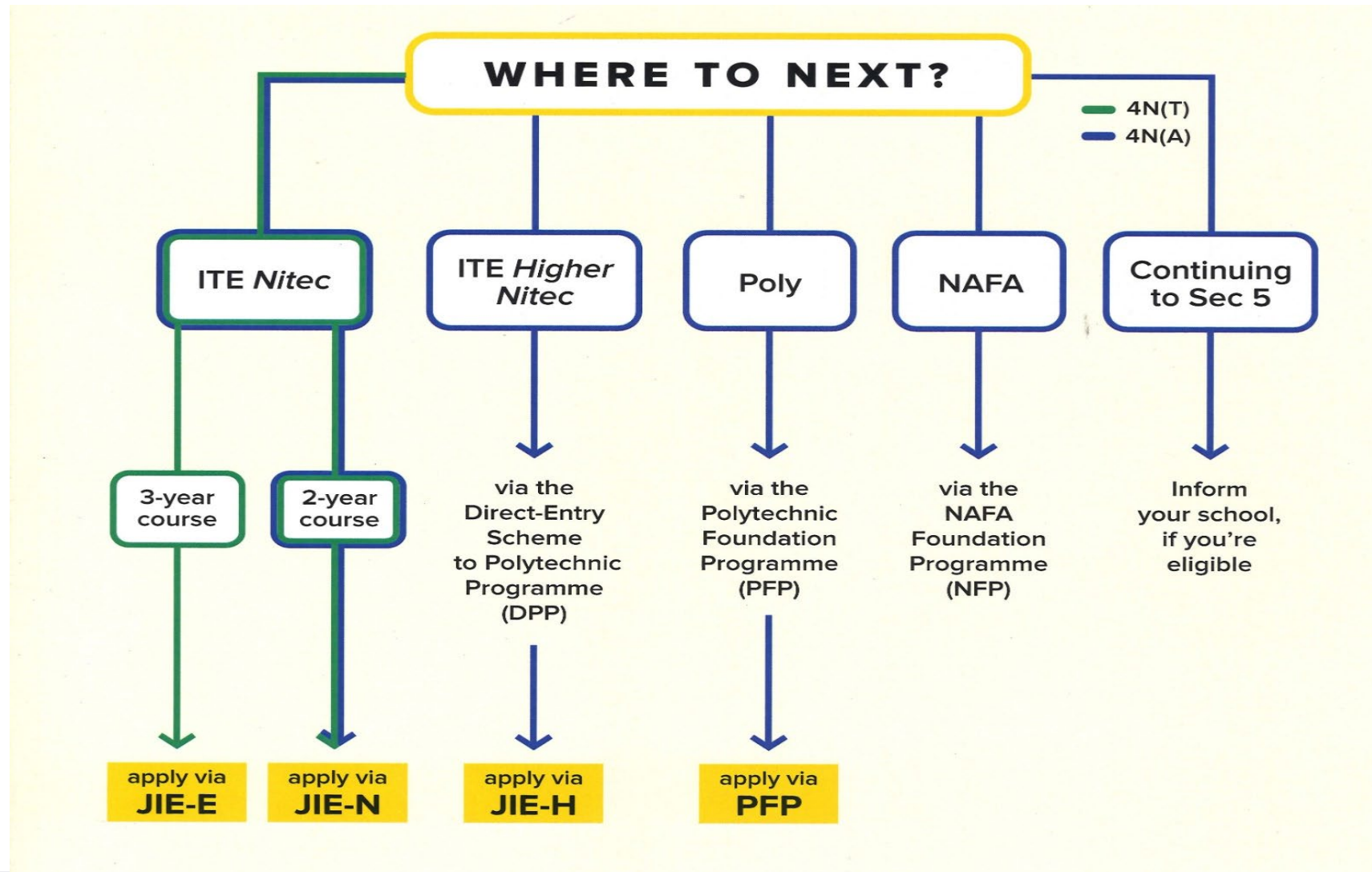

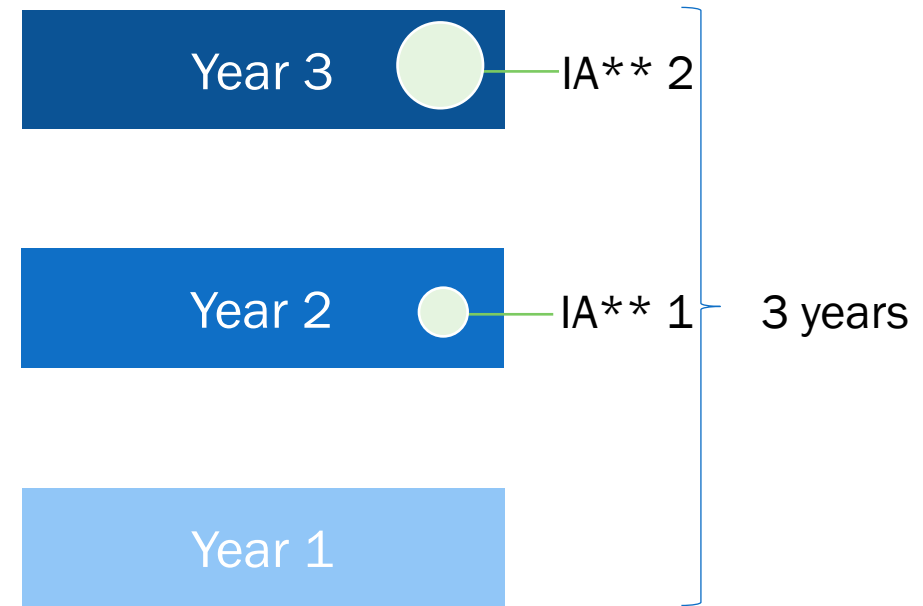
# ITE has redesigned the curriculum to offer all students a 3-year curriculum, with most students achieving a Higher Nitec at the end of their time in ITE

# The enhanced structure streamlines Nitec and Higher Nitec curriculum and features two integrated Industry Attachment

The same quality training, but in a shorter period of time

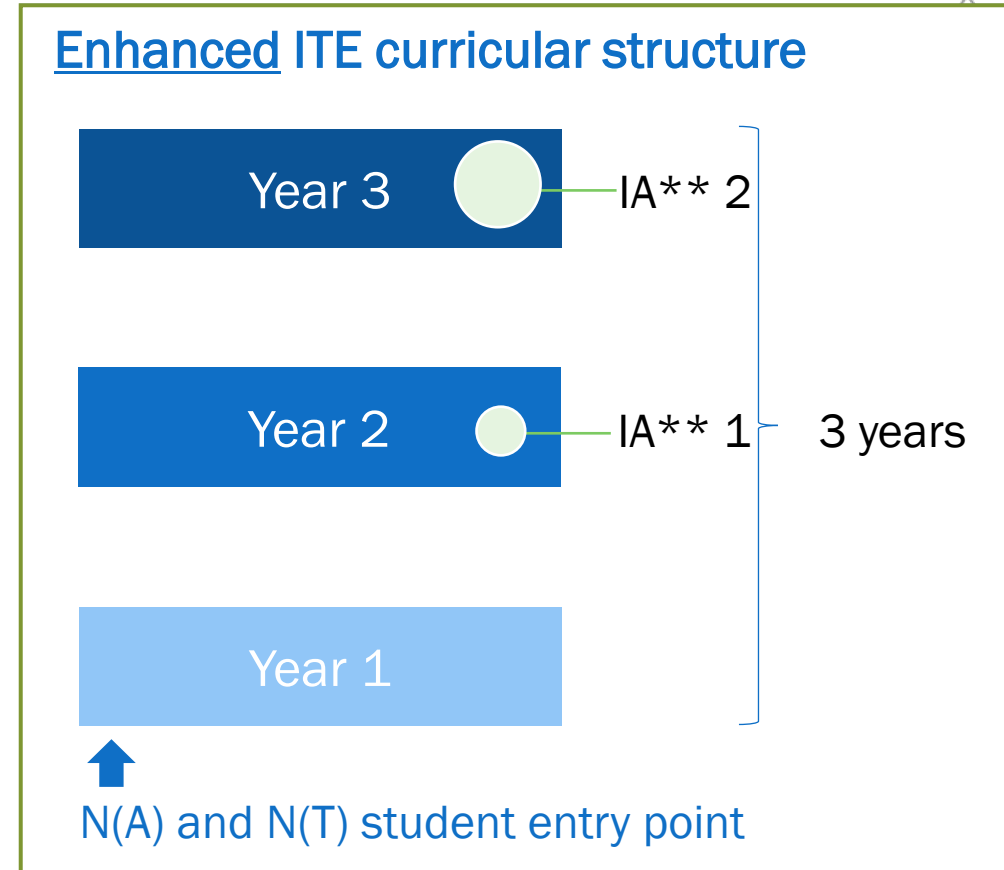
ITE will redesign current modules in Nitec and Higher Nitec, so that you will receive high quality training in a shorter period of time.

You will experience two Industry Attachments in 3 years

All students will undergo a 3-month IA in Year 2 and a 6-month IA in Year 3.

The two IAs will give you more opportunities to learn important skills at the work place.

You will have the chance to practice the skills you have learnt in the classroom to the real world!

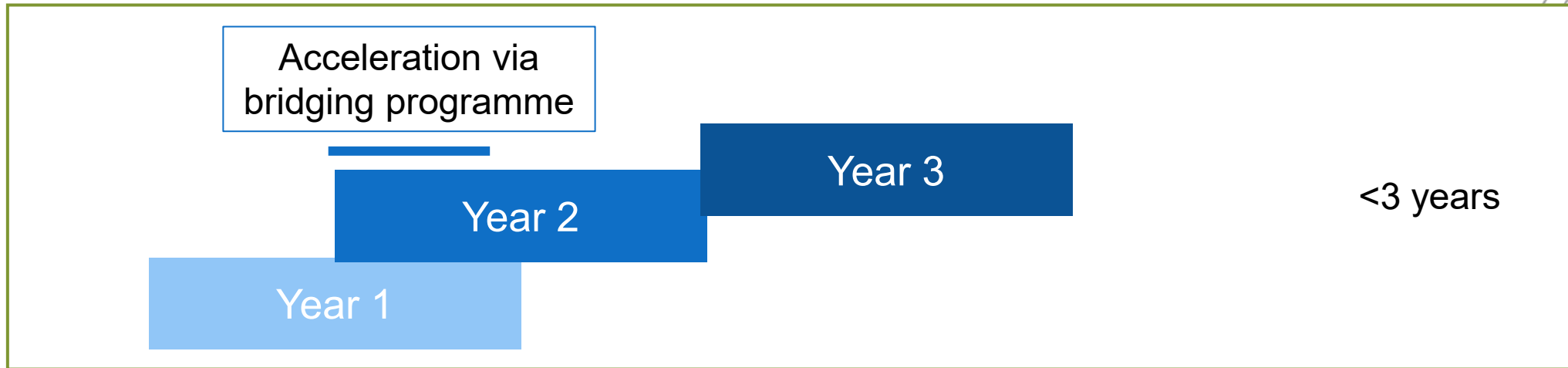

# Flexibility under the enhanced curricular structure

Students do well in Semester 1 of Year 1 may be identified for an accelerated pathway to complete the Higher Nitec course in less than 3 years

# Some courses will move to the new structure first

The 16 courses on the right will move to the new structure first

These courses will take on the new structure from the 2022 intake (that's potentially you!)

Other ITE courses will move to the new structure in phases after 2024

# I am keen on these courses! (1/4)

John will transit seamlessly from his entry at Year 1 to Years 2 and 3, and will complete his Higher Nitec in a shorter period of 3 years, compared to the current curricular structure, where he graduates from Nitec and applies for admission again to Higher Nitec.

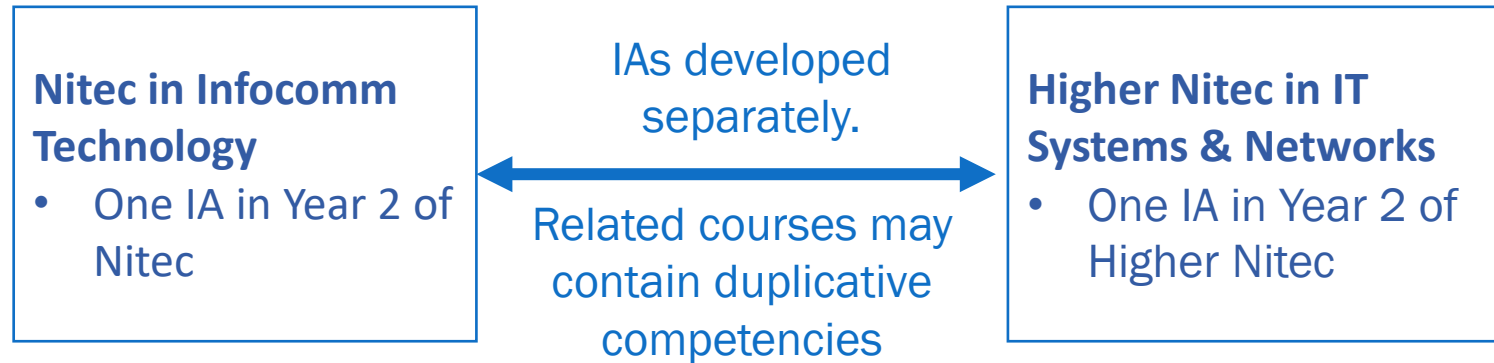

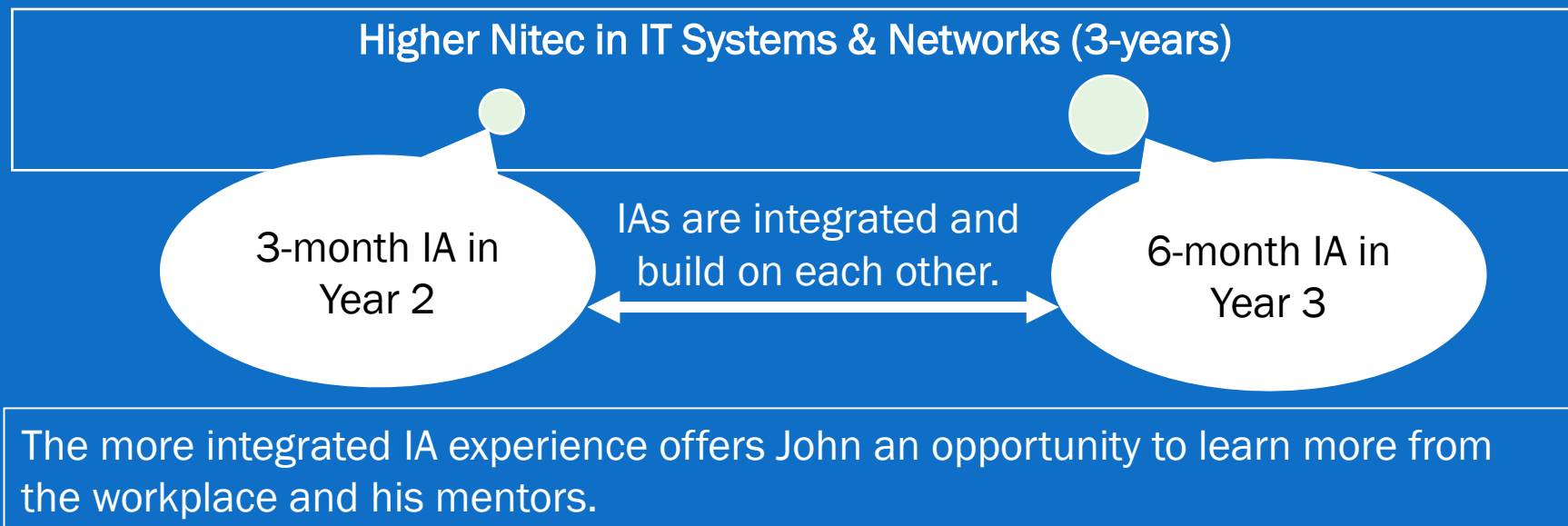

# ITE Early Admissions Exercise

- ITE EAE is an aptitude-based admissions exercise that allows students to apply and receive conditional offers for admission to ITE based on their aptitude and interest, prior to receiving their final GCE N- examination results. It allows ITE greater flexibility in selecting students on a broader measure of criteria other than academic grades, thus allowing a wider range of talents to be recognized.
- Application usually starts after the mid year exams. After which, students may need to attend try-outs, interviews, etc., during the June holidays.
- Even when offer is accepted, the student still need to meet the minimum requirements, and must pass all subjects.



# You can apply for all ITE courses (regardless whether they will move to the new structure first) through ITE EAE

The ITE EAE begins in May 2021. You can start to prepare for the application!

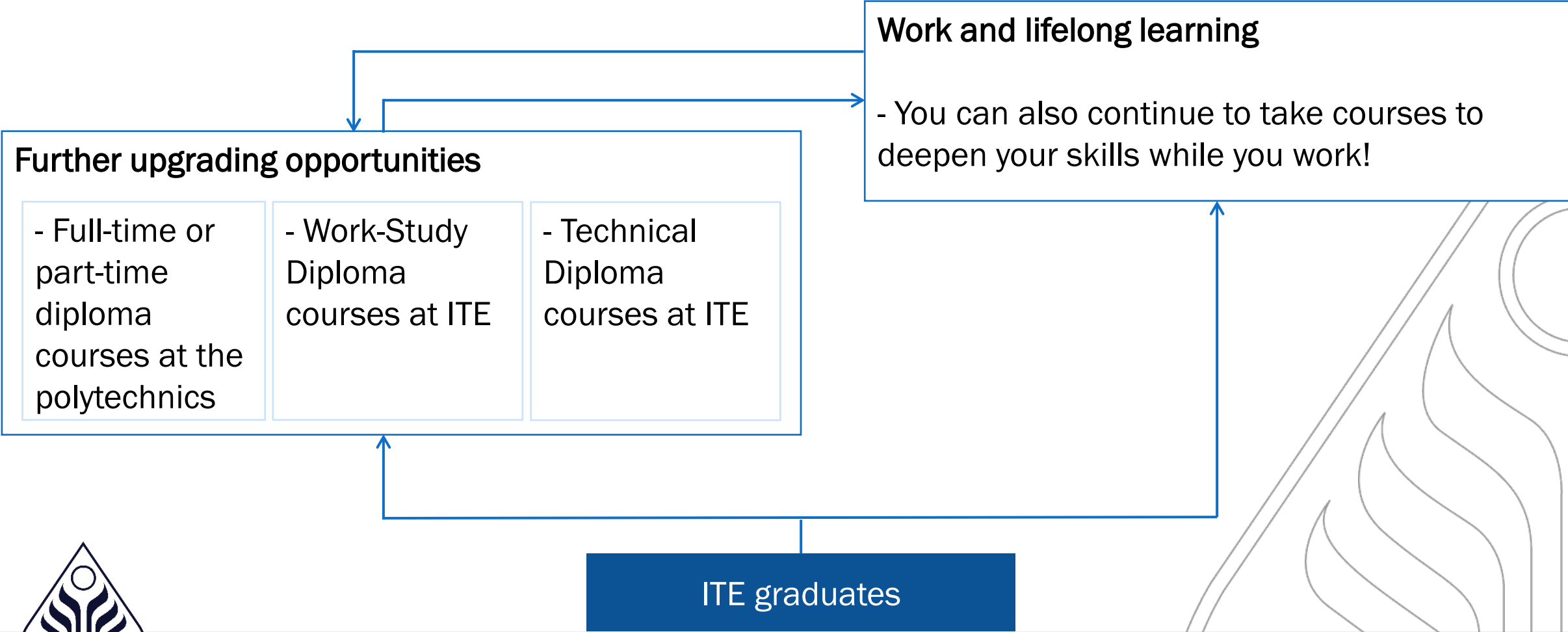
